Official Information request and response

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act ("OIA") dated 10 May 2025 and extended till 8 July 2025.

You have requested:

- 1. A letter dated around September 2022 from then broadcasting minister Willie Jackson to NZ on Air discussing the reallocation of funds from NZ on Air to the planned Aotearoa New Zealand public media entity.
- 2. A copy of the draft 2023/24 Discussion Paper on the transition year of the establishment of the Aotearoa NZ Public Media entity.

I have attached the requested information that we are able to release:

- 1. A copy of the letter from Minister Jackson to NZ On Air conveying the impact on NZ On Air's baseline funding should Parliament pass the Aotearoa New Zealand Public Media Bill.
- 2. A copy of the draft 2023/24 Discussion Paper on the transition year strategy if the Aotearoa NZ Public Media entity (ANZPM) was established. We have withheld some information in this document under s 9(2)(g)(i) of the OIA to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression between officers or employees of an agency in the course of their duty.

Please note this is also an unfinalised internal planning document and was not intended for public release in this form. The ANZPM Bill was <u>withdrawn</u> and ultimately not established. This stopped further work intended to refine this strategy and so this document has no current relevance.
