Official Information request and response

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act ("OIA") dated 30 September 2025.

You have requested:

I am urgently seeking, under the terms of the above Act, the details of all NZ on Air funding that has been granted to South Pacific Pictures shows/productions - and South Pacific Pictures-related companies and productions - from January 1, 2023 to September 30, 2025 inclusive.

This includes, please, the name of the productions/shows/series/films, the total funding agreed by NZ on Air for each project, and the progress (or otherwise) of existing funding applications.

This includes funding for shows such as The Traitors NZ and Shortland Street.

Please see below a list of projects approved for NZ On Air funding from 1 January 2023 to 30 September 2025 produced by South Pacific Pictures or a related Special Purpose Vehicle, and the approved funding amount. As we have not received a response from you in relation to clarifying "the progress (or otherwise) of existing funding applications," we have interpreted this part of your request as whether NZ On Air's funding has been contracted with the recipient.
