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Content

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This is the 21st edition of the *Local Content Report*. NZ On Air created this report in 1989, the first of its kind in the world, to begin measuring the amount of local content on New Zealand screens. In order to give perspective to our funding policies, we needed to know just how broadcasters were faring in providing audiences with programming about New Zealanders and their country.

There is over four times the amount of local content on our screens now than when we began measuring output. Its quality, range and diversity have vastly improved over the years.

In 2009, 11,418 New Zealand-made hours screened on the six main free-to-air channels, with still more on pay television and regional and digital channels. Local programmes include *Outrageous Fortune*, *Beyond The Darklands*, *Go Girls*, *What's Really In Our Food?*, *Artsville*, *Sticky TV* and *Pakipumeka*. Schedule stalwarts *What Now?*, *Fair Go* and *Country Calendar* are all well past their twenty-one year screening marks and still cherished by their audiences. The networks also invest heavily in news, current affairs and sports programmes.

This year, despite the economic downturn, levels of local content stayed relatively stable. Both TV2 and TV3 increased their first-run hours. TV One's dipped, but that channel screened by far the highest level of New Zealand programming.

New Zealand programmes cover a rich diversity of stories, perspectives and people. From a broadcaster's perspective it's far easier - and cheaper - to buy successful foreign programmes off the shelf than invest in unknown new programmes where the full cost of production has to be met. NZ On Air was created to help bridge the gap for higher cost, higher risk programmes, but it's important to note that most local content hours are still financed by the networks themselves.

NZ On Air pays tribute to all the broadcast personnel who back local content and get it on the airwaves. And we acknowledge the invaluable contribution of the several thousand screen industry personnel who apply their outstanding skills and talents to making programmes loved by New Zealanders both at home and abroad.

NZ On Air

For 21 years NZ On Air has been measuring local content on free-to-air channels. Five years ago Prime TV joined TV One, TV2, and TV3 and four years ago MTS and C4 were added to the line up.

In 1989 we recorded 2,804 hours of local programming. 20 years later, with six nationwide channels screening local programmes, total hours were 11,418 compared with 11,601 hours in 2008. This is a small decrease in a year when all sectors of the New Zealand economy were feeling the effects of the global recession.

It is important to note that the figures in this report are for mainstream, free-to-air channels only. TVNZ 6, TVNZ 7, regional channels and the MTS Te Reo channel all screen locally made programmes which add more hours of local content. Still more hours screen on pay television. With the increase in channels it is impossible to measure all local content. This survey provides a useful measure of trends over time on the six main channels.

Overview: more channels, more local content

In 2009 TV One and MTS recorded the most local content; Prime and C4 the least. Three channels increased their hours slightly, TV2, TV3 and Prime; the others showed a small decrease. The channel recording the biggest increase in local content since 2008 is TV3.

Children's Programmes, Documentary, Information, Māori Programmes for a general audience and News/Current Affairs are genres recording an increase in 2009. Total hours include repeats.

In 2009 there were 741 documentary hours recorded on six channels. By way of comparison in 1989 there were only 36 documentary hours screened on three channels: TV One, TV2 and TV3. NZ On Air's 2009 Public Perceptions research confirmed documentary as a favourite genre and indicated that the definition of documentary is expanding.

Free-to-air television key trends

- Local content hours decreased by 183 hours to 11,418 hours. This represents a 1.6% decrease in local content in 2009 and the first time there has been a decrease since 2004.
- The percentage of local content on the six free-to-air channels dipped slightly to 33.7% of the schedule (34% in 2008).
- TV One screened the most local content, with 3,812 hours (*1,782 hours in 1989*).
- As in previous years MTS screened the second highest number of hours with 2,544 hours. 82% of MTS broadcast hours is local content programming (84% in 2008).
- Both TV One and MTS showed a small decrease in local content hours: TV One by 142 hours and MTS by 64 hours.
- TV3 showed the biggest increase with 138 hours added to their schedule, totalling 2,114 hours of local content (*1,976 hours in 2008*).
- TV2's hours increased slightly to 1,129 hours (*1,110 hours in 2008*).

- Although Prime's local content increased, the channel screened the least: 846 hours.
- Most of C4's 975 hours consist of music videos.
- **First-run hours**, representing new series or programmes, decreased by 5% to 8,498 hours (8,936 hours in 2008), mainly due to decreases in the Entertainment, Information and Sports genres. Increases were in Children's, Documentary, Māori programmes and News/Current Affairs.
- TV One screened the most first-run local content with 3,232 first-run hours. Next was TV3 with 1,926 hours, followed by MTS with 1,062 first-run hours. Prime, MTS and C4 showed a decrease.
- **Prime time** local content decreased to 3,430 hours (3,701 hours in 2008). This was mainly due to decreases on TV One and MTS.
- Local content comprised 39% of prime time schedules (42% in 2008; 42.5% in 2007; 43% in 2006).
- MTS screened the most local content in prime time with 786 hours, representing 25% of the prime time schedule. This is a decrease of 116 hours over the 2008 figures.
- **Total hours** of Children's programmes, Documentaries, Information, News/ Current Affairs and Māori programmes for a general audience increased, while Drama/Comedy, Entertainment and Sports hours decreased.
- **Repeat** screenings comprised 2,920 hours (2,664 hours in 2008), accounting for 26% of local content programming (23% in 2008). MTS screened the highest number of repeats. Programmes that screen first on another channel, e.g. *Tagata Pasifika* on TV One is regarded as a repeated programme on MTS.

(MTS and C4 have fewer total broadcast hours compared with the other channels.)

NZ On Air funding

NZ On Air funding covers both high cost and high risk programmes and lower cost special interest programming. Our funding supports only a small portion of the overall local content screened in New Zealand.

In 2009 NZ On Air funds contributed to:

- 20% of total local content
- 19% of first-run programmes (18% in 2008)
- 28% of local content screening in prime time.

Each year NZ On Air invests around \$90 million in free-to-air television programmes to purchase around 800 hours of local content: from dramas such as *Go Girls*, *Outrageous Fortune* and *The Cult* to special interest series such as *Minority Voices*, *Attitude*, *My God* and *Tagata Pasifika*.

NZ On Air also invests in Children's programmes such as *Buzzy Bee and Friends* and *The Erin Simpson Show*; Children's Drama, *Paradise Cafe*, and Comedy programmes including *7 Days, bro'Town* and *The Jaquie Brown Diaries*.

2009 - Total Hours (by Channel)

This survey concentrates on the 18 hour clock (6am - midnight).

11,418 hours of local content accounted for 33.7% of the total 6am - midnight broadcast hours across the six channels in 2009 (34% in 2008).

Results by channel follow:

TV One

- Total local content hours were 3,812 hours, a decrease of 142 hours (3,954 hours in 2008).
- Local content filled 58% of the 6am - midnight schedule (60% in 2008).
- 51% of prime time comprised locally made programming.
- TV One still screens more local content than any other channel, largely due to its News/Current Affairs, Information, Sports and Documentary outputs.
- TV One's figures reveal a decrease of 195 hours of **first-run** or new programming: 3,232 hours in 2009 (3,427 hours in 2008). However, Māori programming increased by 45 hours, Documentary by 24 hours and Drama/Comedy by 6 first-run hours.
- Including repeated programmes, Māori programmes increased by 66 hours, due to the increased duration of *Te Karere*; and Documentary hours increased by 60.
- Drama/Comedy, Entertainment, News/Current Affairs and Sports hours decreased.

TV2

- TV2's local content hours increased by 19 hours to 1,129 hours (1,110 hours in 2008).
- Local content made up 17% of the 6am to midnight schedule, the same as in 2008.
- 20% of TV2's prime time programming comprised local content.
- TV2 **first-run** hours increased by 61 hours to 683 hours (622 hours in 2008).
- Genres to see an increase in **first-run hours** were: Children's with 66 hours of new programming, including three hours of first-run Children's Drama; Drama/Comedy with 9 extra hours; Māori Programmes with 21 added hours; Sports with 18 extra hours and Entertainment with 11 added first-run hours. These were offset by decreases in first-run Documentary and Information programmes.
- The greatest decreases in **total hours** were seen in Information (44 fewer hours) and Documentary (38 fewer hours).

TV3

- TV3 increased its local content by 138 hours in 2009, reaching a total of 2,114 hours (1,976 hours in 2008).
- Local content comprised 32% of the 6am - midnight schedule (30% in 2008).
- 44% of prime time scheduling consisted of locally made programming.
- TV3's **first-run** local programming increased by 81 hours mainly due to increased News/Current Affairs and Drama/Comedy (1,926 hours in 2009, 1,845 hours in 2008).
- News/Current Affairs **first-run** programming increased by 110 hours, Drama/Comedy by 11 hours and Māori programmes by 10 hours when compared with 2008 figures.
- Decreases in **first-run** hours were seen in Documentary by 10 hours, Entertainment by 22 hours and Information by 23 hours.
- **Total hours** increased in Drama/Comedy, News/Current Affairs and Māori programmes.
- Children's Drama and Entertainment were the only genres showing small decreases in total hours, in comparison with 2008 figures.

Prime

- **Total hours** rose by 29 hours to 846 hours (817 hours in 2008).
- Local content was 13% of the 6am - midnight schedule (12% in 2008).
- 13% of prime time comprised local content.
- **First-run** programming decreased by 21 hours to 664 hours (685 hours in 2008).
- Prime screened more Sports hours than any other free-to-air channel, clocking up 606 hours, 58 more than in the previous year. There were an extra 13 **first-run** Sports hours.
- Entertainment hours were down to a total of 17 hours (36 in 2008).
- There were 15 hours of **first-run** Information programming, 8 hours fewer than in 2008.
- **First-run** documentary programming increased and there were losses in Entertainment, Information and News/Current Affairs first-run hours.

C4

- In calculating local content hours on C4 an allowance of two hours per day is made for local music videos, some of which are funded by NZ On Air. In 2009 a different system has been used for calculating total local content, in particular on the music show *The Official NZ Top 40*. This accounts for the decrease in C4 hours when compared with 2008 figures.
- Total local content comprised 975 hours, representing 22% of the 6am - midnight schedule (25% in 2008). Almost all were music videos.
- C4's **first-run** local content was 930 hours, a decrease of almost 200 hours.
- 53% of **prime time** viewing comprised local content.
- Entertainment comprised 940 hours (1,108 hours in 2008). There were 19 hours of Drama/Comedy and 13 hours of Documentary, a 4 hour increase over 2008 figures.

(C4's free-to-air VHF schedule is the only platform we measure. C4 also transmits via a digital signal on Sky and Freeview with extended hours not measured in this survey.)

Māori Television (MTS)

- With average broadcast of 8.5 hours per day plus extended hours on Anzac Day, total local content measured 2,544 hours, 64 fewer hours than in 2008.
- Local content was 82% of the 6am - midnight schedule compared with 84% in 2008. Almost half the local content broadcast hours were repeated programmes.
- 54% of **prime time** viewing comprised local content.
- **First-run** programming decreased by 181 hours. Documentary was the only genre with an increase in first-run hours, reaching 90 hours, a 16 hour increase over 2008.
- **Total hours** increased in the following genres: Information by 68 hours, Documentary by 15, News/Current Affairs by 18 and Entertainment by 15 hours.
- Decreases in local content hours were seen in two genres: Drama/Comedy by 128 hours and Sports by 54 hours.

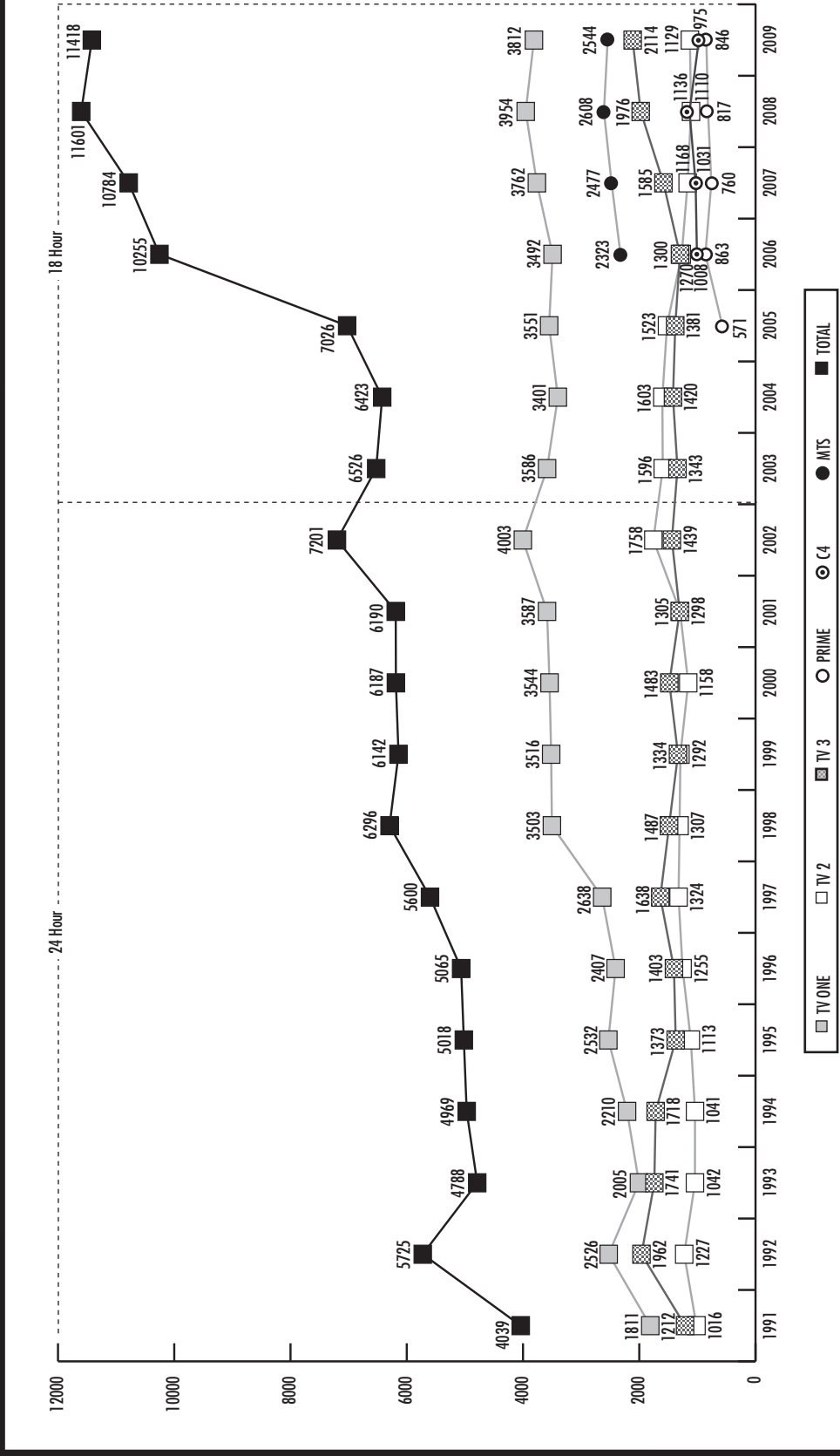

Decreases were seen in the total hours of Drama/Comedy, Entertainment and Sports.

Total hours

- Children's programming increased by 8 hours to 1,043 hours in 2009 (1,035 hours in 2008).
- Children's Drama hours doubled from 12 to 24 hours.
- Documentary hours increased by 50 to 741 hours.
- TV One screened the most documentaries with 354 hours, which included 227 hours of repeats.
- MTS programmed 206 hours of documentaries, including 116 hours of repeats, followed by TV3 with 101 hours, half of which were repeats. Prime and C4 screened 20 hours and 13 hours respectively.
- Drama/Comedy hours were down to 600 hours (711 hours in 2008 and 816 hours in 2007).
- MTS and TV One had the most significant decreases in Drama/Comedy hours, with 16 and 128 hours respectively. This decrease was offset by increases on TV2 and TV3 of 12 hours and 24 hours respectively.
- Entertainment programming, which increased significantly in 2008, dropped to 1,573 hours in 2009. The largest decreases were on TV One, C4 and Prime with 86, 68, and 19 fewer hours respectively.
- Information is the genre with the most local content hours after News/Current Affairs. The total increased by 34 hours in 2009 to 1,742 hours, principally on TV One and MTS. Both channels boosted their Information hours: 940 hours on TV One and 608 hours on MTS. TV3 recorded 146 hours and TV2's hours decreased by 44 to a total of 27 hours.

- Māori programming for general audiences (excluding MTS) showed a major increase from 223 hours in 2008 to 333 hours in 2009. TV One had the biggest increase with a total of 232 hours, an extra 76 hours and TV2 almost doubled its total, from 24 hours to 45 hours. TV3 increased its hours by 13 to 56 hours. Prime and C4 have no Māori programming.
- News/Current Affairs hours have increased steadily ever since records began. 3,750 hours screened on five of the six channels, an increase of 90 extra hours over 2008 figures. TV3 showed the biggest increase with 108 hours; MTS recorded an extra 18 hours. These figures are offset by decreases on TV One and TV2. In spite of its decrease, TV One screens the most News /Current Affairs with 1,717 hours.
- Sports hours were 1,613 (1,754 hours in 2008). The lack of major international events (*The Olympics* and *The Paralympics* were held in 2008) account for much of the 141 hour decrease.

First-run Hours

First-run hours are a significant indicator of the amount of new investment in New Zealand programming in any particular year. First-run hours include programmes screened in prime time (peak) and off peak slots.

Total first-run hours in 2009 decreased by 438 hours, a 5% decrease.

Increases in 2009 first-run hours were achieved by:

- TV2 which increased by 61 hours to a new high of 683 hours.
- TV3 which increased by 81 hours to 1,926 hours.

Decreases in 2009 first-run hours were experienced by:

- TV One which decreased by 195 hours to a total of 3,232 hours.
- Prime which decreased by 21 hours to 664 hours.
- C4 which decreased by 183 hours to 930 hours.
- MTS which decreased by 181 hours to 1,062 hours.

News and Current Affairs programmes have a high quantitative effect. If these hours are excluded, a more representative picture of trends in other genres is revealed.

Excluding News/Current Affairs:

- TV One screened 24% first-run local content (27% in 2008).
- TV2 screened 10% first-run local content (9% in 2008).
- TV3 screened 9% first-run local content (9% in 2008).
- Prime screened 7% first-run local content (7% in 2008).
- C4 screened 21% first-run local content (24% in 2008).
- MTS screened 26% first-run local content (32% in 2008).

First-run Changes to Note in 2009

The increases in first-run hours were offset by decreases in three main genres: Entertainment hours were down by 303 hours, Information by 200 hours and Sports hours decreased 189 hours.

- **Children's** first-run programming, including Drama, increased to 594 hours. With 66 hours of new programming on TV2, the main broadcaster of Children's programming. TV2's total was 320 hours. This includes 7 hours of Children's Drama, the only channel to screen first-run Drama for children. TV3's total is 157 hours and MTS screened 117 first-run hours.
- **Documentary** first-run hours were up by 16 to 318 hours (302 hours in 2008). Increases on TV One with a total of 127 first-run hours, MTS with 90 hours, C4 with 7 hours and Prime with 6 hours, partially offset the decrease in hours on TV2 (19 fewer hours) and TV3 (10 fewer hours).

- **Drama/Comedy**, which dropped in 2008 increased by 6 hours to reach 251 hours in 2009. TV2 entertained viewers with 155 hours of Drama/Comedy, 10 more than the previous year. TV3 had 45 hours of first-run programming, 11 more than in 2008 and TV One played 28 hours. MTS screened 18 hours of first-run Drama/Comedy, the same as in the previous year. Prime had no Drama/Comedy and C4 had 6 hours.
- **Entertainment** has continued to be variable: down in 2007, up in 2008 and down again in 2009 by 303 hours to a total of 1,208 hours. C4 significantly adds to the total with 914 hours of mainly music videos, a decrease of 179 hours when compared with 2008 figures. MTS was next with 128 hours, 17 hours less than the previous year. TV One's 69 hours represents 84 fewer hours than in 2008. TV2 screened 49 first-run hours, up by 11 hours on 2008 figures. TV3's total was 50 hours of first-run Entertainment programming, a decrease of 22 hours over the previous year.
- **Information** first-run hours continued to reduce: 1,186 in 2009 (1,386 in 2008 and 1,474 in 2007). TV One is the channel with most first-run hours and showed a small increase to reach 819 hours but the other channels post sizeable decreases: MTS screened 250 hours, 129 hours fewer than in the previous year. TV3's first-run programming decreased by 23 hours to 75 hours; TV2's total dropped from 71 first-run hours in 2008 to 27 hours in 2009; and Prime's figures decreased by 8 hours to a total of 15 hours.
- **Māori Programmes** for general audiences showed a 76 hour increase. (We do not record this category for MTS: 'Māori programmes' on MTS are distributed across all the genres.) The three main channels all show a healthy increase in first-run hours of Māori programming: TV One by 45 hours, TV2 by 21 hours and TV3 by 10 hours. Prime and C4 have no programmes in this genre.
- **First-run News/Current Affairs** hours increased by 94 hours to 3,454 hours. The main increase was on TV3.
- **Sports** hours decreased by 189 hours. The Olympic Games boosted sports hours in 2008. Increases on TV2, TV3 and Prime are offset by a major decrease on TV One, down by 178 hours, and MTS with a drop of 48 hours.

NZ On Air's contribution to total first-run local content hours was 19% (18% in 2008).

Details on first-run local content for each channel follow:

TV One

- First-run local content hours decreased by 195 hours to 3,232 hours (3,427 hours in 2008) due to a drop in Sports hours, which were higher in 2008 on account of major events, particularly *The Olympics*.
- First-run local content represents 49% of TV One's schedule (6am - midnight).
- The greatest increase in first-run hours was in Māori programmes for a general audience. The total increased by 45 hours to 170 hours, due to an increase in the length of *Te Karere*, the Māori News programme now in its 26th year.
- Documentaries increased by 24 hours to 127 hours, due in part to an increase in the number of locally made programmes in the *Real Crime* slot and new series including *Birdland* and *South*.
- Apart from News/Current Affairs, the genre with the most first-run hours is Information with 819 hours. *Minority Voices* and *A Mad Business* were new series in 2009.
- Sports decreased significantly with 177 fewer first-run hours to a total of 368 hours. *The Olympics* and *The Paralympics* contributed to extra hours in 2008.
- Entertainment hours which had increased by 81 hours in 2008 decreased by almost the same amount in 2009. *The Rich List* and *Who Wants to be a Millionaire* are among the shows that did not return.
- Drama/Comedy hours decreased by 3 hours in 2009 to a total of 28 hours and included telefeatures *Until Proven Innocent* and *Piece of My Heart*, which played in the Sunday theatre slot.

TV2

- TV2's first-run local content hours increased by 61 hours bringing the total in line with 2007 figures. Six of the nine genres showed an increase, bringing the total first-run hours to 683 (622 hours in 2008).
- First-run local content programming accounted for 10% of TV2's schedule (9% in 2008, 10% in 2007).
- The biggest increases in first-run hours were: Children's Programming with 63 extra hours bringing the total to 313 hours. New programmes included *Buzzy Bee and Friends*, *The Erin Simpson Show* and *The Wotvots*.
- Māori programmes increased by 21 hours to a total of 45 hours, with added episodes of *Korero Mai*.
- Sports increased by 18 hours with the addition of *Beach Volleyball 2009* to the schedule.
- Drama/Comedy increased by 9 hours to reach a total of 155 first-run hours. New shows included the dramas, *The Cult* and *Go Girls*.
- Information and Documentary recorded decreased hours, with a drop of 44 and 19 hours respectively. The documentary series *Sensing Murder* and *The Lion Man* did not return in 2009 nor did the Information programmes *The Truth Files* and *Home Sick*.

TV3

- First-run local content hours increased by 80 hours to 1,926 hours.
- The percentage of first-run hours increased to 29% (28% in 2008, 22% in 2007).
- The biggest increase was in News/Current Affairs with 110 extra hours of first-run programming. This was due to *ASB Business*, which began late in 2008, running for a full year in 2009. *Sunrise* and *Campbell Live*, which began their seasons two weeks earlier than in 2008, also accounted for extra hours.
- Four other genres showed small increases: Children's Programmes increased by 3 hours to 157 hours; Drama/Comedy increased by 11 hours, partly due to the new programme *7 Days*; Māori programmes by 10 hours to a total of 52 hours, with added episodes of *Pukana*; Sports showed a small increase recording 150 first-run hours. The increase can be attributed to the new car racing competition *NZ V8 Utes*.
- Genres to see decreases were Documentary by 10 hours, (*Inside New Zealand* did not return until late in 2009); Entertainment by 22 hours, partly due to *Joker Poker* and *Deal or No Deal* not returning for a third season; and Information by 23 hours. *The Big Stuff* lifestyle programme premiered in 2008 but did not return in 2009.

Prime

- Prime's first-run local content hours decreased by 21 hours to a total of 664 hours.
- 10% of the schedule was devoted to first-run programming, the same as in 2008.
- Sports hours increased by 13 to a total of 460 hours, with cricket, rugby and rugby league dominating the schedules again: *Cricket One Day Internationals*; *Rugby Super 14*; *Rugby: Air NZ Cup*; and *Rugby League NRL* competitions. A new programme was *The Snow Show*.
- There were 6 hours of first-run Documentaries, two more than in the previous year. A new series of *Extraordinary Kivis* began early in the year and *Flight of the Conchords: On Air* was a one-off documentary.
- Information first-run local content hours decreased from 23 in 2008 to 15 in 2009, due partly to dropping the New Zealand component of the travel programme *Getaway*.
- News/Current Affairs hours, which were boosted by general election programming in 2008, showed a 12 hour decrease to reach a total of 183 hours.
- Entertainment was down by 12 hours and there were no Drama/Comedy programmes in 2009.

C4

- First-run local content represented 930 hours, a decrease of 183 hours (1,113 hours in 2008).
- This represented 21% of the schedule (25% in 2008).
- In 2009 a different system has been used for calculating total local content, in particular on the music show *The Official NZ Top 40*. Previously the full programme was listed as local content but in 2009 12 minutes per hour were counted as New Zealand made. This accounts for much of the decrease in total hours.
- Entertainment was down by 179 hours on the channel that screens mostly musical content.
- Documentary first-run hours increased to 7 hours; there were 3 first-run Sports hours.
- Drama/Comedy decreased from 13 hours in the previous year to a total of six hours.

MTS

- First-run local content was 1,062 hours a drop of 181 first-run hours. Almost all is accounted for by the decrease in first-run Information programming.
- First-run programming represented 34% of the schedule in 2009 (40% in 2008).
- Documentary was the only genre to increase with 16 extra hours bringing the total to 90 hours. This included a new series of *Aunty Moves In* and the *Pakipumeka* documentary strand.
- The biggest decrease was in Information with a total of 250 hours, representing a decrease of 129 hours. *The Indigenous Broadcasters' Conference* covered by MTS accounted for some of the extra hours in 2008.
- Entertainment first-run hours were down by 17 hours to a total of 128 hours. *Sealord Opera in the Park* held in Nelson in 2008 was not performed in 2009 and the series *Matatahi* did not return.

First-run hours (peak and off peak) by channel

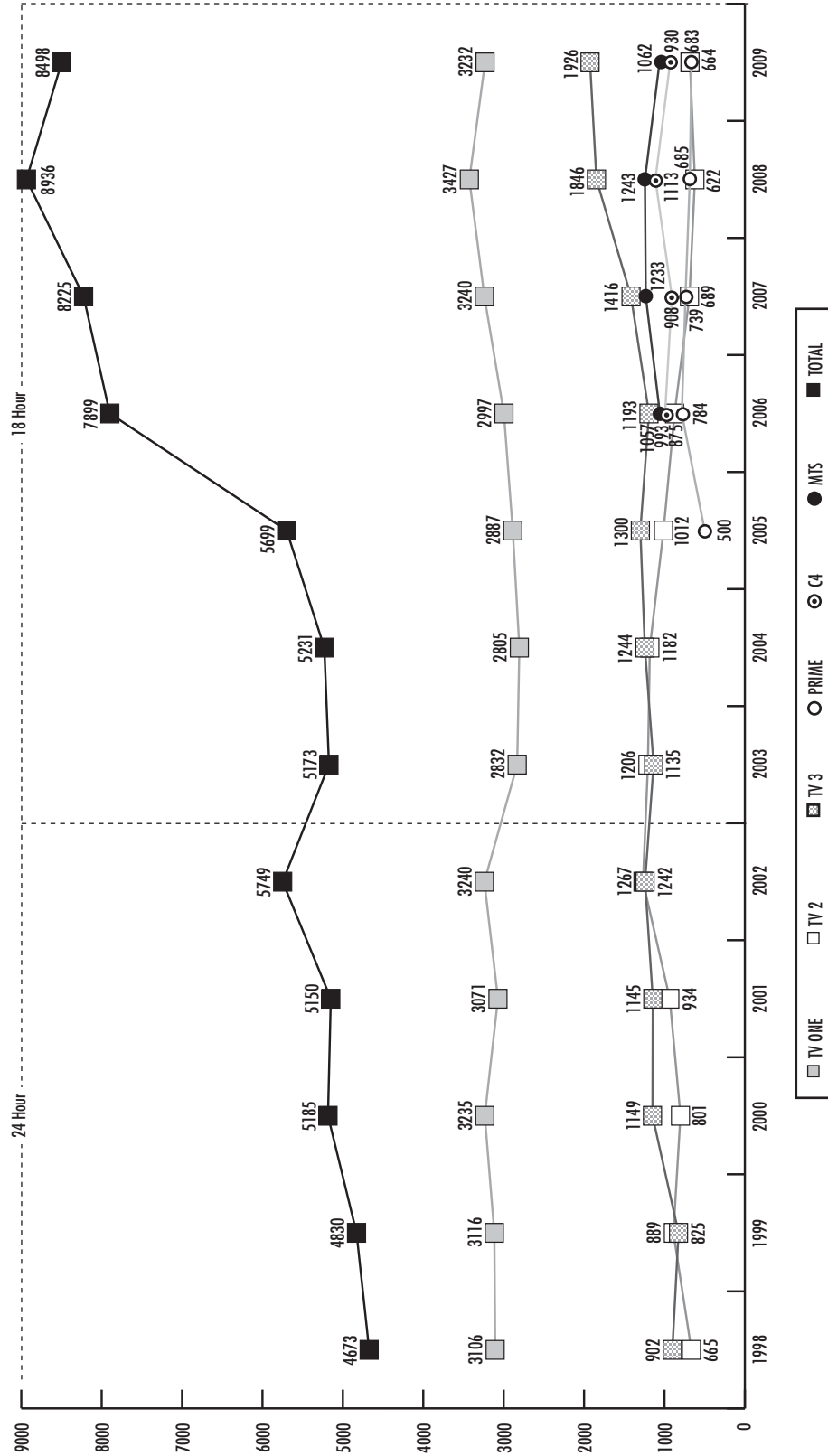

Prime Time Hours

Prime time represents the hours between 6pm - 10pm seven days a week. Across six channels the total was 8,760 hours. (As 2008 was a leap year, prime time hours were 8,784.)

During these four hours, all the networks compete to generate maximum income by attracting the greatest number of viewers. The bulk of their commissioning budgets is spent in this time band. Therefore prime time local content hours are a useful indicator of the status of production spending by the television networks.

Total local content in prime time was 3,430 hours in 2009, a decrease of 271 hours (3,701 hours in 2008, 3,726 hours in 2007). This represented 39% of the prime time schedule (42% in 2008).

- TV One's prime time local content decreased by 95 hours to 748 hours. In 2008 the figures were boosted by general election coverage. News/Current Affairs accounts for the greatest portion of the total with 528 hours. Documentaries increased by 24 hours; Drama/Comedy by 3 hours and the other genres decreased: Entertainment by 31 hours; Information by 10 hours and Sports by 72 hours. There were no Māori programmes in prime time.
- TV2's total prime time local content hours increased by 7 hours to 286, with the bulk of the programming in the Drama/Comedy genre, which increased by 14 hours to 155 hours. Entertainment increased by 11 hours. Documentaries decreased by 20 hours to a total of 40 hours.
- TV3's prime time local content hours increased by 6 hours to 636 hours. Most of the prime time hours are filled by News/Current Affairs: 517 hours. All genres showed increases apart from Information with a 3 hour drop and Documentary, which was down by 10 hours. Drama/Comedy increased by 3 hours and Entertainment by 14 hours.
- Prime's prime time local content hours decreased by 23 hours to 195 hours. Most of the channel's prime time schedule consists of Sport: 185 hours. Local content in prime time represented 13% of the schedule. (Prime's evening News begins at 5.30pm which falls outside prime time.)
- MTS screened the most hours of local content in prime time: 786 hours, a decrease of 116 hours. News/Current Affairs and Information account for the channel's highest number of hours in prime time. The major decrease was in the Information genre, with 95 fewer hours. Sports decreased by 22 hours.
- C4's prime time hours reached 778, almost all of which are music videos.

Details of prime time local content on each channel follows:

TV One

- TV One screened 748 hours of prime time local content, a reduction of 95 hours when compared with 2008.
- Local content in prime time represents 11% of total broadcast time.
- News/Current Affairs accounts for 528 hours of the prime time total, a decrease of 8 hours.
- Prime time Documentaries increased by 24 hours to 116 hours.
- Drama/Comedy increased by 3 hours to 17 hours.
- Entertainment hours halved to 32 hours, compared to 2008 figures; Information was 34 hours.
- Sports were 22 hours, a decrease of 72 hours in prime time in 2009.

TV2

- TV2's total prime time local content hours increased by 7 hours to 286 hours (279 hours in 2008).
- Local content in prime time represents 4% of total broadcast time.
- Documentaries decreased by 20 hours to a total of 40 hours.
- Drama/Comedy increased by 14 hours in prime time to 155 hours.
- Entertainment hours in prime time increased by 11 hours to 46 hours and Information was 27 hours in 2009.
- News/Current Affairs reached a total of 11 hours in prime time.

TV3

- TV3's prime time local content hours increased by 6 hours to 636 hours.
- Local content in prime time represents 10% of total broadcast time.
- News/Current Affairs accounts for 517 hours of the prime time total.
- Documentaries decreased by 10 hours to 38 hours; Information decreased by 4 hours to 21 hours in prime time.
- Drama/Comedy increased by 3 hours to 33 hours and Entertainment by 14 hours to 27 hours.

Prime

- Prime's prime time local content hours in prime time decreased to 195 hours (218 hours in 2008).
- Local content in prime time represents 3% of total broadcast time.
- Sports hours in prime time accounted for the biggest share at 185 hours, almost the same as in 2008.
- Prime screened 2 hours of Documentary and 7 hours of Information in prime time.
- Entertainment hours in prime time decreased by 12 hours to 1 hour in prime time.

C4

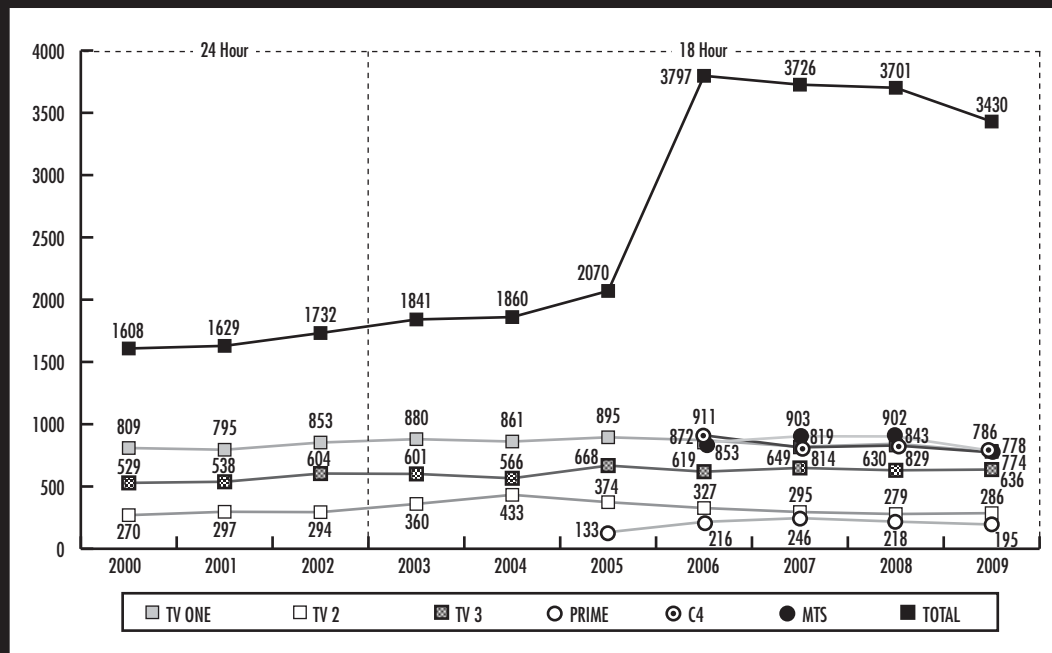
- C4's prime time hours reached 778, almost all of which are music videos in the Entertainment genre at 768 hours.
- Local content in prime time represents 17% of total broadcast time.
- Prime time local content decreased by 41 hours.
- The balance was made up of 7 hours of Documentary and 2 hours of Sport.

MTS

- MTS screened the most hours of local content in prime time: 786 hours, a decrease of 116 hours on 2008 figures.
- Local content in prime time represents 25% of total broadcast time.
- News/Current Affairs totalled 257 hours, the same as in 2008.
- Documentaries increased by 3 hours to 65 hours.
- Information programming dropped by 95 hours to 218 hours.
- Drama/Comedy increased by 3 hours to 17 hours.
- Sports programming decreased by 21 hours to a total of 116 hours in prime time.

Extended Prime Time

This section is added at the request of the networks, which work to 'extended prime time', between 5:30pm and 11pm.

News/Current Affairs programmes make up the bulk of the local content programmes screened during these hours.

TV One

TV One screened an additional 285 hours in the extended period: 130 hours in News/Current Affairs, 34 hours in Entertainment, 26 hours in Information, 11 hours in Drama/Comedy, 4 hours in Documentaries, 12 Sports hours and 69 hours of repeated programmes.

TV2

TV2 screened an additional 22 hours - all in repeated programmes in Documentaries and Drama/Comedy.

TV3

TV3 screened 237 hours in the extended time: 126 hours of News/Current Affairs, 46 hours of Sports, 18 hours of Information, 11 hours of Drama/Comedy and 2 hours of Entertainment programming. The total includes 35 hours of repeats.

Prime

Prime screened 221 hours in the extended period, of which 184 hours were News/Current Affairs. The balance was made up of 6 hours of Sports, 4 hours of Documentary and 28 hours of repeated programmes.

C4

C4 screened 71 additional hours in the extended period of which 25 hours were in the Entertainment genre, and 5 hours in Drama/Comedy. 41 hours were repeated programmes, half of which were Entertainment.

MTS

MTS screened a further 983 hours: 15 hours in Documentary, 14 hours in Information, 12 hours in Entertainment and 1 hour in Sports. The balance was in repeat programming in most genres, including 19 hours of repeated Children's Programmes.

Repeat Hours

Four of the six free-to-air channels run a 24 hour transmission schedule and during the less commercial slots, such as overnight or very early in the morning there is a need for low-cost or no-cost programming. Repeat screenings are generally at no cost to the channel. In their contracts with the networks and New Zealand On Air, production companies agree to a number of repeat screenings of their programmes, within a certain time frame. It is also an efficient use of commissioned programmes.

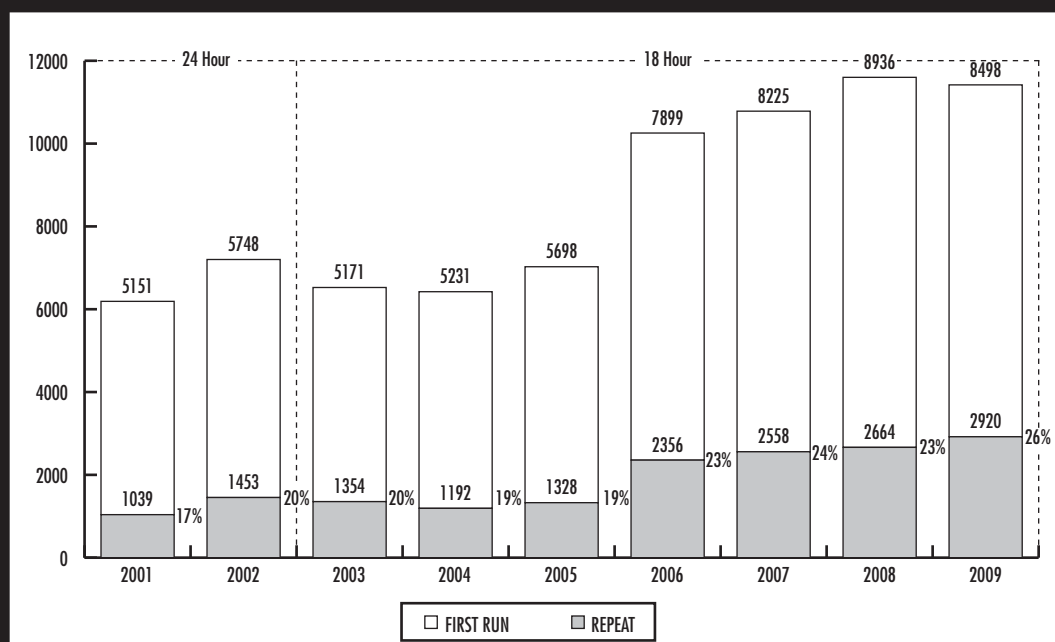
Some programmes, such as those for children, are intended to be repeated and eventually become favourites. They are designed to have a long shelf life to serve new generations of young audiences.

In 2009, repeat screenings comprised 26% of the total local content hours, (23% in 2008, 24% in 2007). Across six channels the total is 2,920 hours, an increase of 256 hours.

- TV One repeated 579 hours of local content (527 hours in 2008). This represents 9% of New Zealand broadcast time in the 18 hour schedule (8% in 2008).
- Repeats decreased on TV2 by 42 hours to a total of 446 hours, representing 7% of the schedule.
- TV3 increased its repeated programmes by 57 hours, to 187 hours, representing 3% of the schedule (2% in 2008).
- Prime repeated 182 hours of local content (132 hours in 2008). This is 3% of the local schedule and all but 30 hours were repeated Sports programming.
- MTS repeated 1,481 hours, which is 48% of the local programme schedule (44% in 2008). This represents an increase of 116 hours. Children's programmes, Information, Sports and Documentaries showed the most repeated hours in the schedule.
- C4's repeat local programming almost doubled from was 23 hours to 45 hours.

A brief summary of the 2009 trends in each genre is listed below. Statistics for the nine genres by channel are in Appendix 2.

Children's Programmes (including Children's Drama)

As Children's programmes screen in off peak (non-commercial) timeslots, broadcasters do not usually commission this genre without substantial financial assistance. NZ On Air is the main funder of this genre committing over \$12 million to Children's programmes and \$3.5 million to Children's Drama in the 2008/9 financial year. This agency supports Children's programming to ensure New Zealand children have locally made programmes with which they can identify.

In 2009 Children's programmes on TV2, TV3 and MTS, increased by 20 hours to reach 1,067 hours. This includes 24 hours of Children's Drama, all of which screened on TV2. 21 years ago there were 534 hours of Children's programming and 25 hours of Children's Drama.

TV2, the main broadcaster of Children's programmes screened 503 hours, of which 166 hours were repeats. First-run programmes increased by 63 hours and included *Buzzy Bee and Friends*, *The Wotwots* and *The Erin Simpson Show*.

New seasons of *What Now?*, *Cool Kids Cooking*, *Activate*, *Studio 2*, *The Erin Simpson Show* and *Just the Job* appeal to young viewers. Among the popular repeated programmes were *The Adventures of Massey Ferguson*, *The Go Show*, *Zip and Mac* and *Puzzle Inc*.

Children's Drama on TV2 increased by 19 hours to a total of 24 hours. 17 hours were repeated programmes. *Paradise Cafe*, a thriller series set in the Pacific, was a new series in 2009. *The Killian Curse*, *Holly's Heroes* and *Karaoke High* were repeated dramas.

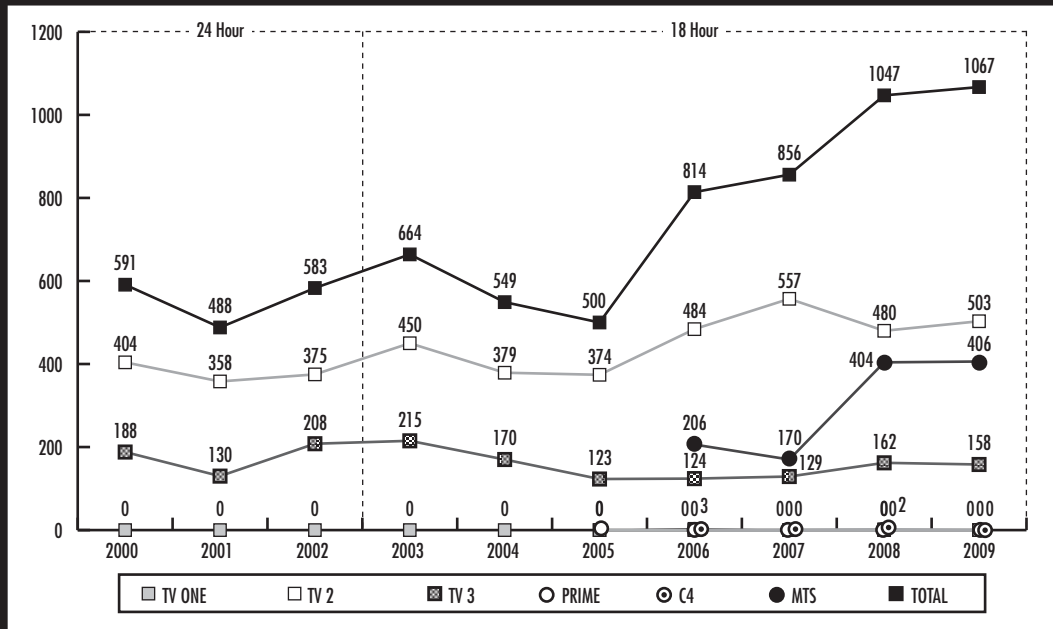
TV3's Children's hours increased slightly to 158 hours but there was no Children's Drama (7 hours screened in 2008). New series of *Sticky TV* and *Action Central* returned and *Bryan and Bobby* was among the repeated programmes.

Children's programming on MTS remained on 406 hours, the same as the previous year. (MTS use te reo to revoice some imported Children's programming including drama, e.g. *Pippa Longstocking*, but those hours are not included in the Local Content Report.) Returning series include *Pukoro* and *Haa. Pukana*, commissioned for TV3 is repeated on MTS. *Korero Ki Nga Kararehe*, *Miharo*, *Tau Ke: Manu Rere*, the Māori language series and *Jane and the Dragon* are among the repeats.

No Children's programming screened on TV One, Prime or C4.

Documentaries

NZ On Air's 2009 Public Perceptions research confirmed Documentary as one of the most popular genres. This agency committed over \$10 million in the 2008/09 financial year (\$12 million in the 2007/08 financial year).

Documentary hours saw an increase in 2009 with the highest number recorded in NZ On Air's 21 years, totalling 741 hours (691 hours in 2008, 621 hours in 2007, 36 hours in 1989). TV One and MTS screened the most New Zealand documentaries, with 354 hours and 206 hours respectively.

TV One screened 127 hours of first-run documentaries, 24 more than in 2008. 116 hours screened in prime time, including one-off programmes such as *The Killing of Sophie Elliot* and new series: *Birdland*, fronted by Jeremy Wells and *South* with Marcus Lush. *One Land*, an historical reality series began at the end of 2009.

Country Calendar now in its 44th year continues. (After *Coronation Street*, *Country Calendar* is considered the longest running television series in the world.) *Intrepid Journeys*, screening in prime time, returned with a mix of first-run and repeated programmes. *Save Our Home* and *The Outsiders* were new series. *Beyond the Darklands*, *Hunger for the Wild*, *The Investigator*, *Coastwatch*, *Location, Location, Location* and *Under Investigation*, a series of medical mysteries, were all returning programmes in 2009.

A series of *Artsville* documentaries celebrated New Zealand artists and performers. Other series included *The Missing*; *Wild Vets*; *How the Other Half Lives* and *The Politically Incorrect Parenting Show*. On Anzac Day, TV One featured *Lost in Libya* and *Saving Face*, both of which screened in off peak slots.

Among the 227 hours of repeats were *History Man - Michael King*; *Wrestling with the Angel (Janet Frame)*; *Colin McCahon - I Am*; and *Leo's Pride (Sister Mary Leo)*.

TV2 screened 40 of its 48 documentary hours in prime time (In 2008 it screened a total of 86 documentary hours). *Illegal New Zealand* and *Trading Houses* were new series in 2009 and *Neighbours at War* and *My House My Castle* returned to TV2's prime time schedule.

TV3's local documentary hours increased to 101 hours (99 hours in 2008). *Million Dollar Catch*, *The Kitchen Job* and *Missing Pieces* were new series and *Inside New Zealand*, TV3's flagship documentary slot, returned with a series of one-off programmes, including *The Shadow of Vietnam*; *Are Vitamins Killing You?* and *Donated to Science*. *What's Really In Our Food?*, *Open Door* and *Money Man* were returning series.

Prime screened 20 hours, of which six were first-run documentary programmes. *Flight of the Conchords: On Air* screened and new series of *Extraordinary Kiwis* began early in the year. *Wild South*, was among the repeats.

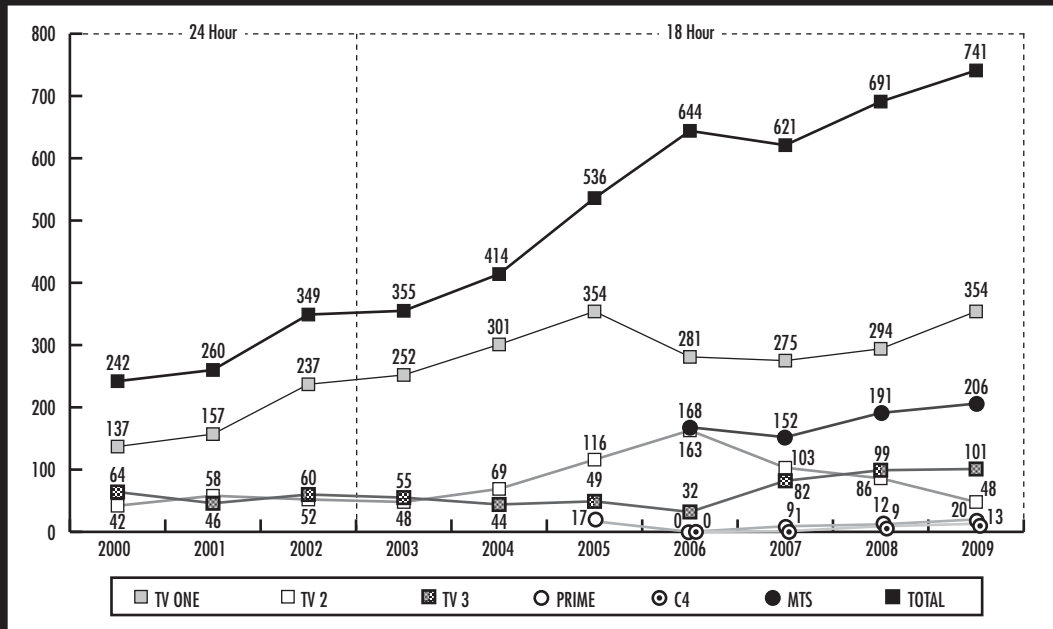
The major documentary series on C4 was the returning *Rocked the Nation*, which also featured in the repeats.

MTS increased its documentary hours by 15 to 206 hours (191 hours in 2008). 65 hours played in prime time and included the new series *Lost in Translation* and programmes in the *Pakipumeka NZ Doco* slot. *Raising the Moko*, *Michael King - A Moment in Time*, *Truth About Māori* and *Skin to Skin* screened in that series.

Anzac Day generates a range of documentaries on MTS and included *An Artist's View on War*; *A Māori Perspective on European War*; *Medals Returned Home* and *NZ Goes to War: Turks in New Zealand* and *WW11 North Africa, Greece & Crete*.

Drama/Comedy

Drama and Comedy programmes are regarded as challenging genres to launch and expensive to create. NZ On Air provided \$35 million in the 2008/09 financial year.

Total hours for the Drama/Comedy genre in 2009 were 600 hours, representing a decrease of 111 hours when compared with 2008 figures (711 hours in 2008, 816 hours in 2007). First-run hours, increased by six hours to reach 251 hours.

Increases on TV2 and TV3 were offset by a decrease of 16 hours on TV One and 28 hours on MTS. Prime time shows *Shortland Street* on TV2 and *Outrageous Fortune* on TV3 feature in New Zealanders top 20 favourite programmes in 2009.

TV One screened 58 hours, of which 17 hours screened in prime time. Tele-features and feature films, *Until Proven Innocent*, *Piece of My Heart*, *Apron Strings*, *Show of Hands* and *Life's a Riot* were part of TV One's 28 hours of first-run programming. *Diplomatic Immunity* was a new comedy and new seasons of *The Pretender* and *The Unauthorised History of New Zealand* screened. Dramas *Burying Brian*, *Whanau* and the 2006 series *Orange Roughies* were repeated.

TV2 screened the most Drama/Comedy hours with a total of 391 hours (379 hours in 2008). 155 hours were first-run programming, a 9 hour increase over 2008. *Go Girls* hit the schedules as a new comedy and *The Cult*, a thriller series, began later in the year. *Comedy Gala* and the series *2 Tube: Uncut* returned. *Ride With the Devil*, *Moon TV* and *Comedy Gala 2008* were among the 236 hours of repeated programmes. The perennial medical drama *Shortland Street* continues five nights a week, providing regular work for New Zealand actors, directors and screen writers. The two hour *Shortland Street Omnibus* edition screens each week.

TV3's hours increased from 48 to 72. The schedule contained fifth series of both *bro'Town* and *Outrageous Fortune*. TV3's Friday night comedy schedule included *The Jaquie Brown Diaries* and the studio show *7 Days*. *AotearoHA: Dai's Christmas Special* was part of TV3's line up. Films including *Once Were Warriors*, *River Queen* and *Out of the Blue* boosted the Drama/Comedy hours.

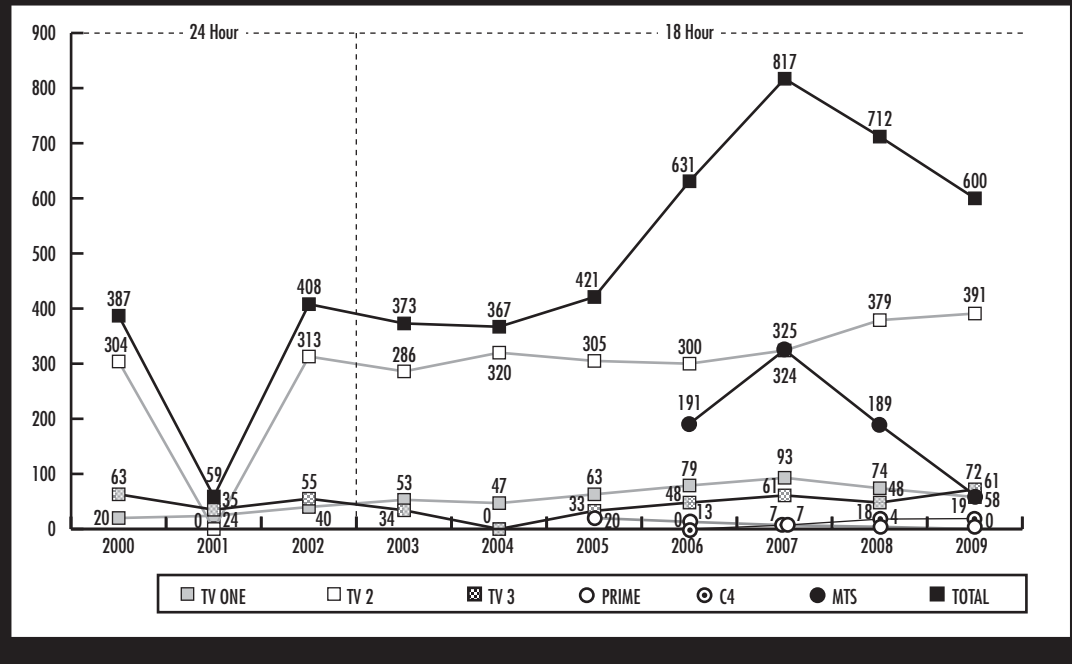
There was a major drop in Drama/Comedy hours on MTS, from 189 in 2008 to 61 hours. Missing from the schedule were *B & B* and *Table Plays*. Among the 18 hours of first-run programmes in this genre was *Iti Pounamu*, a series of Māori short films. Other titles included *O Tamaiti* and *Her Majesty*.

Among the repeated hours were *The Market* and *Kai Korero*.

C4 screened 19 hours of Drama/Comedy including *48 Hours TV* and *bro'Town*, which played first on TV3. The comedy, *Back Of The Y*, was among the repeated programmes. Prime screened no Drama/Comedy in 2009.

Entertainment

In 2009 Entertainment hours were 1,573 across six channels, a decrease of 235 hours (1,808 hours in 2008). Only TV2 and MTS showed increases in the genre but the biggest change to note was the decrease of first-run or new programming. Every channel registered a significant decrease, apart from TV2, which increased its first-run hours by 11 hours to 49 hours of new programming.

TV One's hours were down by 86 hours: 133 hours in 2009 (219 hours in 2008). In 2008 TV One broadcast a number of Olympic Specials, e.g. *Beijing 2008: Opening Ceremony* which boosted TV One's Entertainment hours.

One of New Zealanders' favourite programmes was *Dancing With The Stars*. Also in the top 10 programmes was *Stars in Their Eyes* (NZ). New series of the format shows *Wheel of Fortune* and *The Rich List* returned. *The National Bank Young Farmer Contest* and *Westfield Style Pasifika* also featured on TV One's schedule.

Among the 66 hours of repeats were, *Wonder Dogs* and *Mucking In*.

TV2's Entertainment hours increased by 29 hours to reach 69 hours (40 hours in 2008, 81 hours in 2007). There were 49 first-run hours, most screened in prime time. Programmes include *Top Town*, a show particularly popular in the regions; *Who Dares Wins* and *Island Wars*. *ASB Polyfest* and *The Singing Bee* returned. *NZ Smashes Guinness World Records* featured in the Entertainment lineup and the year ended with *One Night Only*.

TV3's Entertainment hours decreased to 78 hours (84 hours in 2008). There were 50 hours of first-run programming 22 fewer hours than in 2008. TV3 screened award ceremonies: *Qantas Film and Television Awards* and repeats of *Vodafone New Zealand Music Awards*. Schools, teachers and students always tune in for *Stage Challenge*, won this year by Wellington Boys' College.

Other shows include *New Zealand's Next Top Model* and *Hitched*, a behind the scenes series following couples leading up to their wedding; *Big Night In* was TV3's first Telethon in 15 years and raised funds for charity.

Prime screened 17 hours. *Montana World of Wearable Art Awards* was a first-run show screening in prime time. Local Entertainment programming on Prime decreased by 19 hours. Among the repeats were *New Zealand's Got Talent* and *Bassline*.

C4's locally produced Entertainment hours decreased by 168 hours to a total of 940 hours (1,108 hours in 2008). The decrease is largely due to calculating local content in *The Official NZ Top 40* at 12 minutes per hour. Previously the full hour has been counted. C4's Entertainment programming represents 96% of local content hours for this music-oriented channel, almost all of which plays in prime time. An allowance of 2 hours per day is made for local music videos. In addition to this C4 screened *The Nation's Favourite Song*; *Homegrown*; *Smokefree Rockquest*; *Top 10 at 10: Kivis This Decade* and *The Official NZ Top 40*.

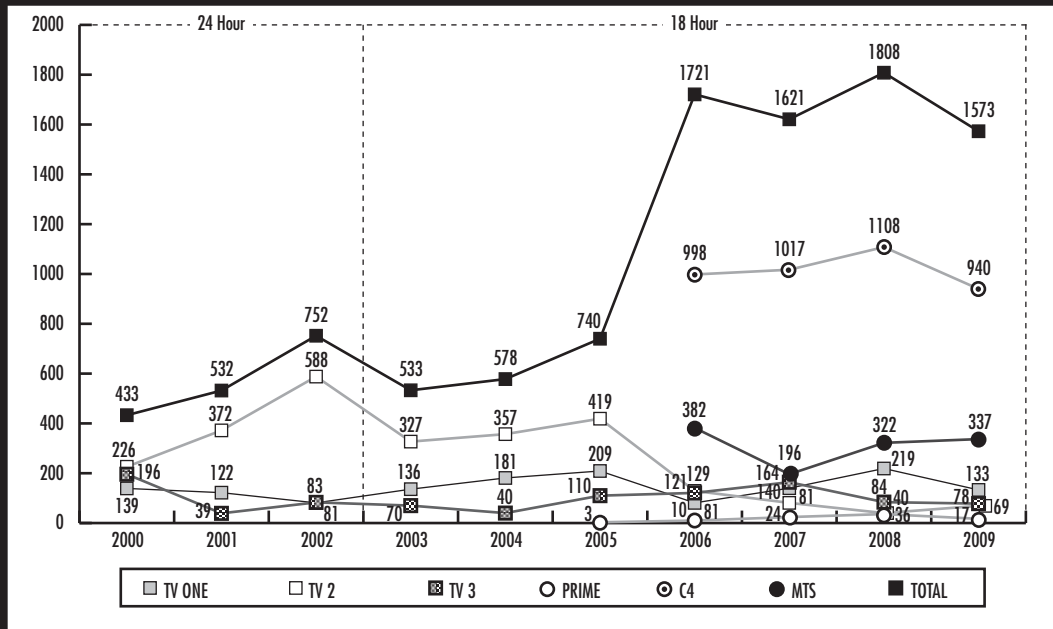
Excluding C4, MTS played the most Entertainment programmes with a total of 337 hours (322 hours in 2008). 114 hours screened in prime time representing 33% of local Entertainment programming on the channel. MTS programmes include the new series of the classic New Zealand gameshow *It's in the Bag*, as well as returning series of *Homai Te Pakipaki* and *Kete Aronui*. Programmes including *Yolande Gibson Sings We'll Meet Again*; ANZAC "Hei Kinaki" and *Toa o Aotearoa* were also on the schedule.

Māorioke Show, *He Matapihi* and *Whare Tapere* are among the 209 hours of repeated programmes.

NZ On Air does not generally fund programmes in the Entertainment genre, as they tend to be sufficiently commercial for broadcasters to fund them independently.

Information Programming

Information, the genre which decreased significantly in 2008, showed an increase of 34 hours in 2009 reaching a total of 1,742 hours.

TV One continued to screen most local Information programming with a total of 940 hours and MTS screened 608 hours, both channels showing an increase over the previous year's figures.

Most of TV One's hours screen in off peak slots, with only 34 hours screening in prime time, with programmes like *Fair Go*, (including the high rating *Fair Go Ad Awards*) always near the top of favourite New Zealand shows. *A Mad Business*, a prime time show, looked at how to succeed in business.

TV One has many Information series targeted at minority groups: *Rural Delivery* for the farming community and a new programme *Minority Voices*, involving ethnic minorities. On Sunday mornings returning series were *My God*; *Tagata Pasifika*; *Attitude*; *Asia Downunder* and *Praise Be*.

Several Anzac day ceremonies featured in Information programming in 2009.

A second series of *New Zealand on a Plate*, screened off peak and took 11 top chefs round the country dishing up culinary delights. *The Road to Ellerslie* was a new programme and *Hunger for the Wild* returned. At the end of the year TV One screened *Carols in the Caves* and *ONE Decade in the Making*. *Homefront Extra*, *Why We Buy* and *The Big Picture* were among the 120 hours of repeated shows.

TV2 decreased its Information programming by 43 hours. It screened a total of 27 hours, all first-run programming in prime time (71 prime time first-run hours in 2008). Programmes included *Police 10-7*, *Mitre 10 Dream Home*; *Rescue 1*; *My House My Castle* and *Trading Houses*. *Mitre 10 DIY Rescue* and *Nought to Five* were among the repeats.

TV3's local Information hours were 146 hours (148 hours in 2008), but there were 23 fewer hours of first-run programming in 2009. 21 hours screened in prime time and 71 hours were repeated shows. An 11th season of the consumer affairs show *Target* returned in prime time and *ITM Fishing Show* was on air in the extended prime time slot at 5.30pm. Among the returning programmes was *Pacific Beat Street*, a series for young Pacific people focussing on issues, styles and trends. *Sunrise Anzac Special* was included in TV3's line up.

Prime's Information programming decreased to 21 hours (26 hours in 2008, 56 hours in 2007). New shows included *Freeze TV*. *Our Place* was among the repeated programmes.

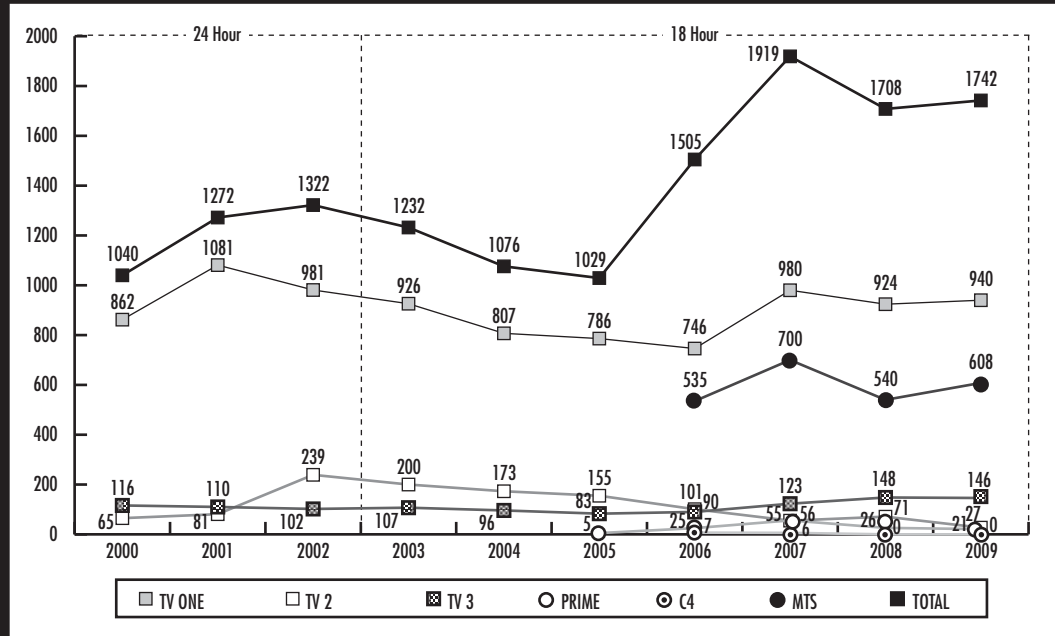
This is the second year that C4 screened no Information programmes.

608 hours of Information programming on MTS represent a 68 hour increase. However first-run programming in this genre was down by 129 hours to a total of 250 hours (379 hours in 2008). MTS had the most hours in prime time: 218 hours playing between 6pm and 10pm and representing 35% of MTS Information hours. *The Great Land Debate*, *Kotahi Te Ra: Waitangi Day*; *Tangaroa with Pio* and *Warrant of Fitness* were among the first-run programmes. *Toko Reo*, was a new Māori language programme in prime time and *Maara Kai* was a series showing viewers how to grow their own food and vegetables.

NZ On Air provided funding support for several shows in the Information category, notably special interest programming such as *Attitude*, *Asia Downunder*, *My God*, *Tagata Pasifika*, *Rural Delivery*, *ANZAC Day 2009*, and *Praise Be* on TV One. It also provided funding for TV3's *Pacific Beat Street*.

Māori Programming

The total hours of Māori programming for a general audience increased by 110 hours to 333 hours in 2009. There is no Māori programming category on MTS. (All programmes are classified by genre e.g. Documentary, Comedy/Drama, Information etc.)

TV One's Māori programming hours increased by 76 to 232 hours (156 hours in 2008) and first-run programming increased by 45 hours. All 170 first-run hours screened in off peak times. *Te Karere*, *Waka Huia*, *Marae* and *Marae Summer Season* are well established programmes on TV One. They are repeated as part of the schedule.

Te Karere had a longer average run-time for each episode in 2009 than in previous years.

TV2 screened 45 hours (24 hours in 2008). Programmes included *Korero Mai - Speak to Me* and *I Am TV*.

TV3's total hours for Māori programming increased to 56 hours (43 hours in 2008). Series include *Tu Te Puehu* and *Pukana*.

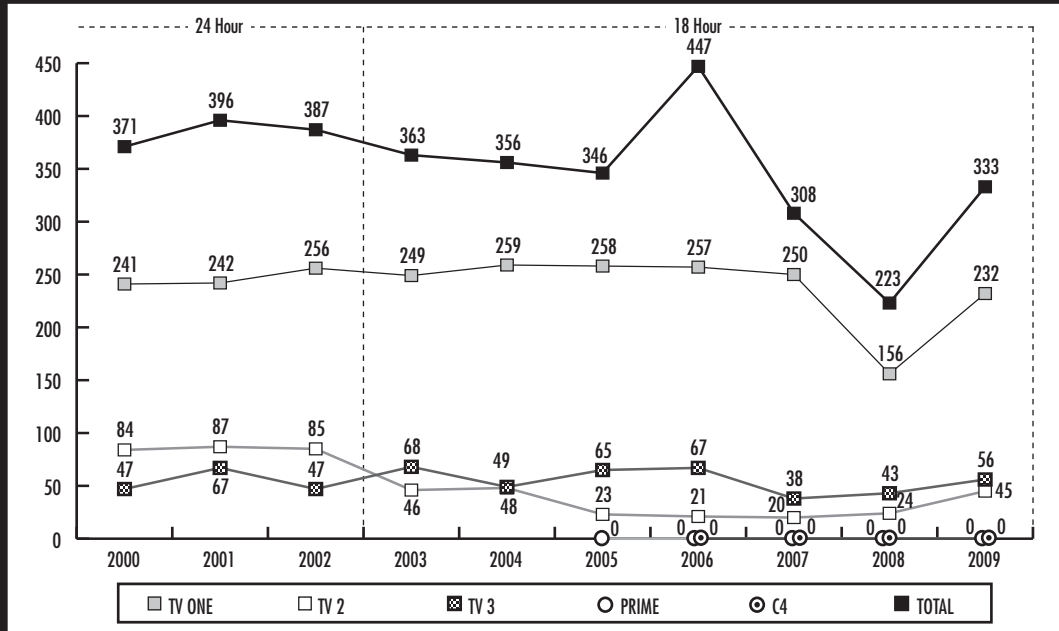
As in previous years all Māori programming on TV One, TV2 and TV3 screened off peak. No Māori programmes screened on Prime or C4.

MTS screened *Waka Huia* and *Marae*, which screened first on TV One. *Pukana*, classified under the Children's genre for MTS, and *Tu Te Puehu*, classified as Information on MTS, screened first on TV3 as Māori programming.

Te Māngai Pāho is the principal funder of Māori programming, much of which is in Te Reo and often subtitled. NZ On Air contributes funding to Māori programmes considered to be of interest to a mainstream audience including Māori and usually in English.

News/Current Affairs

News/Current Affairs hours continue to rise reaching 3,750 hours in 2009 (3,660 hours in 2008, 2,961 hours in 2007). This represents 33% of all local content hours.

TV One screens more News/Current Affairs hours than any other channel, with 1,717 hours (1,739 hours in 2008). The increased hours in 2008 were due to programmes focused on the election campaign.

TV One's programmes are *One News at Midday*, *One News at 4.30pm*, *News at 6pm*, (the cornerstone of TV One's schedule and the start of prime time) and the off peak late night programme, *One News Tonight*.

The daily *NZI Business* and *Breakfast* shows are repackaged as into a weekly format for weekend transmission. Other Current Affairs programmes are *Q & A*, *Breakfast*, *Close Up*, *Sunday*, and *Eye To Eye*.

There were fewer extended One News specials in 2009 than in the previous year, and included: *Budget Special* and *2010 FIFA World Cup Draw*.

TV2's 11 hours are the local content segment of the Current Affairs show *20/20*, which screens on Thursday nights and is repeated.

TV3 screened 1,352 hours an increase of 108 hours. *3 News* and *Nightline* are the major News programmes; *Sunrise*, *Newsday*, *3 News at 12* and *ASB Business* are part of the weekday schedule. *Campbell Live* returned five nights a week as did the weekly *60 Minutes*. *@ Seven* began in the *Campbell Live* slot at the end of the year accounting for an increase in the hours.

Prime's News/Current Affairs programming decreased slightly to 183 hours (195 hours in 2008). *Prime News* screens at 5.30pm.

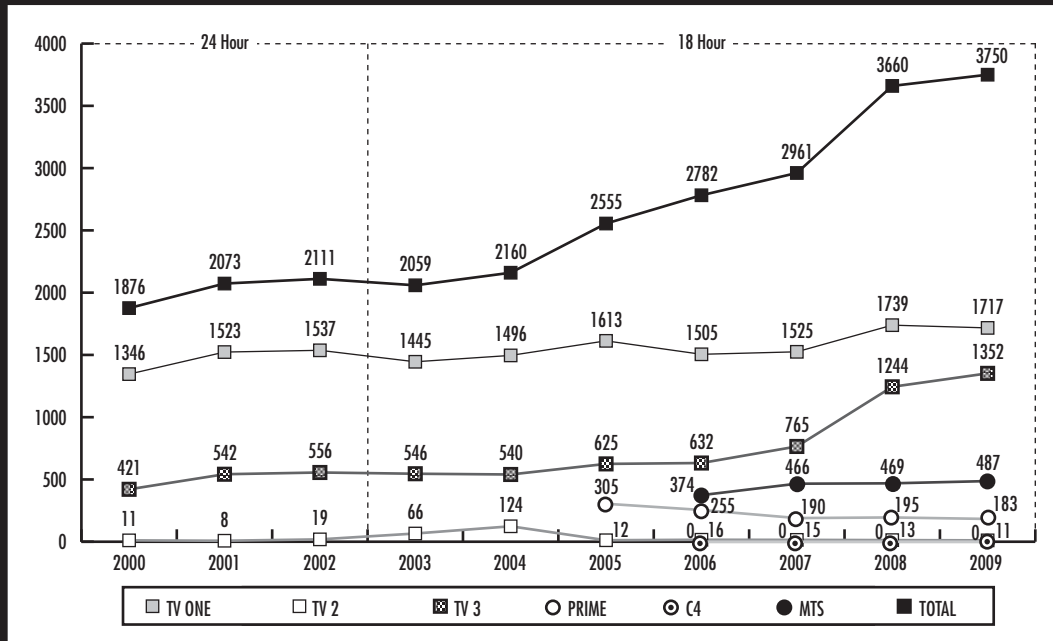
No local News/Current Affairs programming screened on C4.

News/Current Affairs programmes on MTS accounted for 487 hours, an increase of 18 hours. 257 hours of first-run programming screened in prime time and the remainder were repeated hours, including *Marae Summer Special*. *Te Kaea* anchored the News schedule and other programming included *Native Affairs*, *Te Heteri*, *Te Tepu* and *Eye to Eye*, which screens first on TV One. A new series, *Willie Jackson's NewsBites* was added to the schedule.

NZ On Air does not generally contribute funding to News/Current Affairs programmes however this policy was reviewed in 2009. When calculating New Zealand input in Current Affairs shows, e.g. *20/20* on TV2 and *60 Minutes* on TV3 a proportion is allocated for local content.

Sports

International sporting events such the Olympic Games, the Commonwealth Games, America's Cup and the Rugby World Cup cause total sports coverage to fluctuate dramatically from year to year. In 2009 without any of the major international events listed above involving New Zealand teams, the total sports hours decreased by 141 hours to 1,613 hours. 2008 was an Olympic Games year, when sports hours were boosted.

Prime, the channel screening most sport, showed an increase of 64 hours to reach 606 hours. MTS screened 440 hours, a decrease of 54 hours.

TV One's hours were 378, a drop of 178 first-run hours. Most programmes screened off peak and covered a diverse range of sports including: tennis: *ASB Classic* and *2009 Heineken Open*; car racing: *Powerbuilt Tools Motorsport*; yachting: *Louis Vuitton Pacific Series* and the NZ segments of *World Match Racing Tour*; aquatic sports: *NZ Ocean Swim Series* and rowing: *The Gallagher Great Race*; equestrian: *Horse of the Year 2009*; and multisports: *Contact Tri TV* and *North Shore Beach series*.

Winter sports included rugby, *IRB World Sevens* and football, *FIFA Conference Cup*. Hockey and netball were also part of the winter schedule.

TV2 Sports hours doubled from 18 hours in 2008 to 36 hours in 2009. All TV2's sports programmes are first-run and screen mainly in off peak slots. They include *Surf Club 174* and *Beach Volleyball '09*. *Small Blacks TV* features rugby stars, competitions, quizzes, segments on health and fitness and screens on Sunday mornings. *Vodafone One Tribe TV* is a late night rugby league show.

TV3 played 151 hours in off peak slots. The year began with *Sports Tonight's 5th Birthday Bash*. 3 Sport covered the *A1GP Sprint and Feature Race series*; *HSBC NZPGA Championships*; *3 Sport Horseracing: Christchurch Casino NZ Cup* and *The NZ Trotting Cup*. TV3's primary sports programming comprises the *V8 Supercars* and *V8 Utes series*, here and in Australia. When the races are off shore and New Zealanders are competing, a proportion of the competition is allotted for local content.

Prime's local sports hours continue to rise: 606 hours in 2009 (545 hours in 2008). Prime's total sports hours represent 72% of the channel's local content and featured mainly cricket, rugby and league. Rugby started before the cricket season had finished with the *Rugby Super 14* games starting hot on the heels of the *Cricket One Day Internationals*. New series included *Speed Machine* and *Rugby Air New Zealand Cup*. *Rugby League NRL* series returned and *Rugby Tri Nations* games were part of the schedule. *Black Magic Fishing*, *Speed Machine* and *The Crowd Goes Wild* are returning shows.

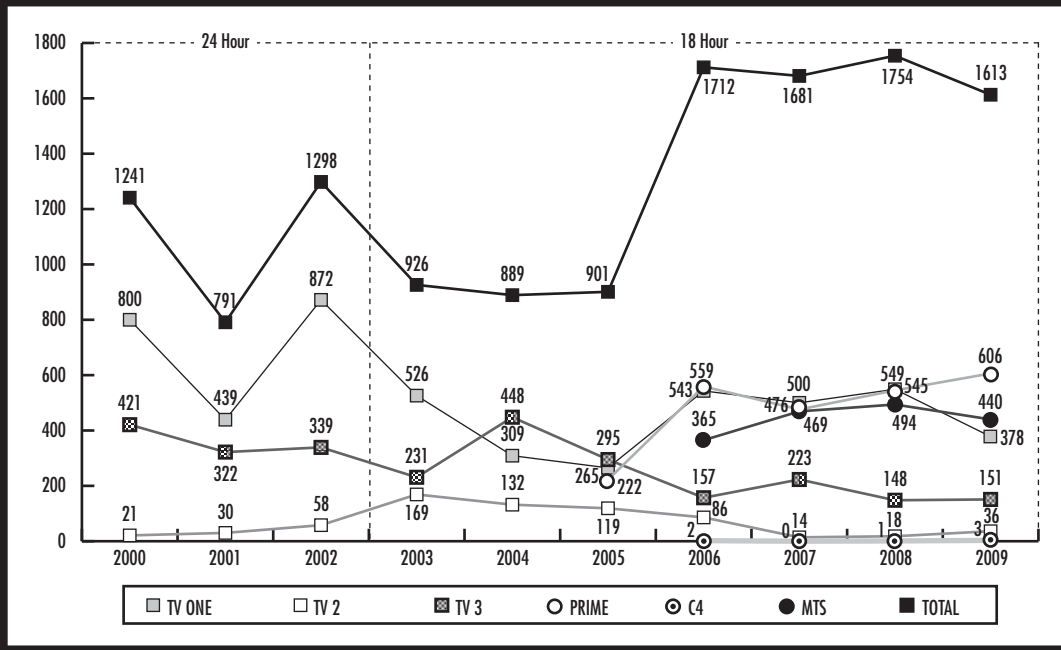
There were 3 hours of local sport on C4.

Among its 440 hours of sports MTS screened *Waka Ama Sprint Nationals*, *Boxing: The Home Coming Fight*, *Cameron v Davis* and later in the year *Cameron v Tua - Te Tini a Whiro*. New series were *Hyundai Summer of Surfing* and *Jam Session*. Rugby league, basketball and boxing are major sports on MTS accounting for the majority of their 440 hours. *Poitukohu NBL* features prominently in the schedule and *Hyundai Code* is a sports entertainment show.

Programmes including *Touch NZ: Youth Open Nationals* and *Pacific Nationals Cup: NZ Māori vs Samoa* were among the repeats.

Freeview Channels: TVNZ 6 & 7

More channels, more local content: this is the second year we have listed data supplied by TVNZ for their digital channels. Many NZ On Air funded programmes have a second screening on these channels, after the first screening on TV One or TV2. The data is not checked by this agency.

TVNZ's digital channels, TVNZ 6 and TVNZ 7, are advertising-free public service channels funded by the government and broadcast on the Freeview platform. Since July 2009 they have also been available to viewers on the Sky TV platform.

TVNZ 6 launched on 30 September 2007 and focuses on 'shared viewing' for a family audience. TVNZ 7 launched in March 2008 and features news (10 minute bulletins on the hour and an hour long evening bulletin), documentaries, current affairs, arts and commentary shows.

Local content, both newly commissioned and acquired, is a key element of the programme schedule for both channels.

Regional Channels

Over the past sixteen years, regional television broadcasting has been playing an increasingly significant role in the country's broadcast tapestry. Channels are spread from Kaitaia to Invercargill, each reflecting the nature of the local communities they serve.

NZ On Air provides some funding for programmes made for regional channels. Many programmes funded by this agency have repeat screenings on the 10 regional channels round the country.

Specific data is unable to be recorded for regional channels.

Notes On Methodology

1. For the six free-to-air channels, data from the *Listener* programme billings is recorded onto an Access database. Scheduling changes by the television networks after *New Zealand Listener* publication are generally not included; nor are unlisted programmes such as short filler programmes.
2. Programmes have, in most cases, been counted according to the amount of New Zealand content within the programme. For example, series such as *20/20* which averages two overseas stories and one New Zealand-produced story per episode, have been recorded as containing one-third of an hour of New Zealand content (two thirds in the case of *60 Minutes*). There is a degree of arbitrariness to such allocations, but the emphasis is on consistency so trends can be observed.
3. Sports programmes are the main example of programmes that fluctuate significantly, and the New Zealand content is not always published in detail in advance. For accuracy Sports programmes would have to be timed as they go to air. As this is not practicable for NZ On Air, all sports content included within New Zealand-produced branded programmes has been counted as a New Zealand programme. For sports matches not featuring a New Zealand team, but which include a New Zealand commentator “topping and tailing” the broadcast, an allowance is made for the presenter links only.
4. If a programme straddles prime time and off peak, it is counted as prime time if the majority of the programme screens in prime time. For example, if a programme begins screening at 9.15pm and concludes at 10.15pm, it is counted as one hour of prime time.
5. In general, programmes are counted as whole hours or half hours irrespective of the differing durations often encountered. For example, a programme may actually have a duration of between 22 minutes and 29 minutes, depending on the length of advertising and promotion breaks, but is counted as a full half-hour for simplicity.
6. First-run programmes mean programmes that are appearing on a *free-to-air national network* for the first time. If a programme screened on C4 first, and was then repeated on TV3, the latter screenings are counted as a repeat. Previous screenings on pay television are not counted.
7. New Zealand content is classified as material which is both predominantly made in New Zealand and which reflects New Zealand identity and culture. Thus programmes which are made in New Zealand but which have no New Zealand flavour are not counted. Neither are programmes about New Zealand but made for foreign television channels.
8. Programme hours are divided into nine genre categories. The categories are:

Children's

Programmes which use New Zealand presenters to provide links between cartoons and other overseas material, or which have a minority of New Zealand content are classified by the amount of New Zealand content only. Programmes which contain some overseas content but have a majority of New Zealand content, such as *What Now?*, are fully classified as New Zealand programmes.

Children's Drama

This is scripted drama made for young people.

Drama/Comedy

This category contains all New Zealand-made Drama/Comedy, other than Drama made for children.

Documentaries

This category generally comprises one-off documentaries or series in a non-magazine format.

Entertainment

This category includes game shows, music programmes (from classical to rock), quizzes and competitions such as *The Rich List* and *Dancing with the Stars*, broad competitive formats such as *Mitre 10 Dream Home* and *Deal or No Deal* plus light entertainment shows.

Information

This category comprises a wide range of programme types, generally with a magazine format and/or an information flavour, as opposed to an entertainment or a competitive purpose. Examples include series such as *Minority Voices*, *Pacific Beat Street* and *Kai Time on the Road*; spiritual series such as *My God* and *Praise Be*; leisure and lifestyle series such as *Gone Fishin'*; and special interest series such as *Attitude*, *Asia Downunder* and *Tagata Pasifika*.

Māori Programmes

Programmes made for a general audience, such as *Marae*, *Waka Huia* and *Te Karere*, are counted in this category.

News/Current Affairs

This comprises all New Zealand-produced News/Current Affairs programmes. One-off advertised events are included, but special bulletins which have not been advertised may be excluded. For programmes which are a mixture of New Zealand and overseas material, such as *20/20*, only the New Zealand portion is counted.

Sports

This category includes all programmes packaged and produced in New Zealand. This is the only category which can contain a high level of overseas content and still be classified as a New Zealand programme. See paragraph 3 on the previous page.

9. Within each category, and by channel, programmes can be further analysed, depending on whether they are:
 - prime time (first-run programming screening between 6pm - 10pm)
