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Chairman's Introduction 2008

One of the first pieces of research published by NZ On Air was the *Local Content Report*. We created this quantitative report, the first of its kind in the world, to begin measuring the amount of local content on New Zealand screens. To give perspective in developing funding policies we needed a longitudinal picture of how broadcasters were faring in providing audiences with programming about New Zealanders and their country.

Twenty years later, looking back at the 1989 report is worthwhile. Compiled by Dr Geoff Lealand the report notes the arrival of third channel TV3 in November 1989, and the increased length of the transmission day with the new 6.30am starts. It also noted that, in March 1989, 44.1% of programming hailed from the United States, 28.4% was from Great Britain, 5.4% was from Australia, and 20.7% was made in New Zealand.

Local programmes screened that year included *The Billy T. James Show, Public Eye, Shark In The Park, Blind Date, Sale Of The Century, The Benson & Hedges Fashion Awards, Spot On and Telethon.*

TV One broadcast 41.5% local content, TV2 22.85% and TV3 (for its first two months of transmission) 20.79%. There were 2,804 hours of local content broadcast.

Dr Lealand noted:

From 1988 onwards TVNZ has been gearing itself up for the arrival of TV3, tightening up and constantly revising matters of presentation and channel image, and totally overhauling news and current affairs to meet a snappy TV3 head on. Game shows and light entertainment are deemed more commercial and make for better ratings than home grown drama and docos. They are also much cheaper and quicker to make in these times of belt tightening.

Fast forward to 2008 and many of the issues still resonate. But, remarkably, there is four times the amount of local content now on our screens.

This new report records 11,600 New Zealand-made hours telecast in 2008 on six free to air channels, a figure almost inconceivable twenty years ago. And there is still more on pay channels, regional and digital channels. Local programmes include *Outrageous Fortune, bro'Town, Dancing With The Stars, Artsville* - and *What Now?, Fair Go* and *Country Calendar*, all well past their twenty year screening marks and still cherished by their audiences.

But the economic issues for broadcasters in providing adequate levels of local content are the same as they have always been. Foreign content is available to purchase at a fraction of its production cost. While New Zealanders make some of the most cost-effective programming in the world, producing a programme is always significantly more expensive than purchasing it off the shelf. For this reason most countries have market incentives to redress this imbalance, either programme quotas or public funding. The creation of NZ On Air was New Zealand's response, providing contestable public funding for specific at-risk genres such as drama, documentary and children's programmes.

The results speak for themselves, across two decades during which providing local content has never been a simple task:

In 2008's transformed 24 hour, multi-channel, fragmented, digital broadcast world, the presence of our own stories and culture in a globalised environment both reflects and contributes to our sense of national identity. And television's lead role in stimulating the screen production sector to thrive must also be noted. These are the outcomes 1989's far-sighted Broadcasting Act envisaged that NZ On Air should seek and the ones to which we are proud to contribute.

Executive Summary (2008)

This survey measures the local content screening between 6am – midnight on the six major nationwide free-to-air channels: TV One, TV2, TV3, C4, Prime and Māori Television (MTS).

One of the benefits of the expanding broadcasting environment is the increase in the number of screens playing New Zealand-made programmes. This is the third year that local content figures for MTS and C4 have been included in the report and the fourth year for Prime.

To illustrate the increase that has occurred over the last 19 years, local content hours across three channels in 1990 measured only 4,249 hours, compared with 11,600 hours on six channels in 2008 (10,784 in 2007).

2008 was a leap year, giving another 24 hours in which to screen local content; a four yearly opportunity and a bonus!

The total hours available for local content were boosted in 2008 by the launch of Freeview including TVNZ 6 and TVNZ 7 and the MTS Te Reo channel, New Zealand's first 100% Māori language channel. Te Reo has been broadcasting three hours a day from 8pm to 11pm seven days a week. NZ On Air does not monitor Freeview hours or local content on pay television channels. Unaudited data from Sky TV, Regional Channels and TVNZ is appended separately (see Other Channels p40).

Overview: more channels, more local content

On four of the six channels surveyed in 2008 local content increased. TV One screened the most local content and Prime the least. The channel recording the biggest increase in local content since 2007 was TV3.

News/Current Affairs, Entertainment and Children's programmes are the genres that recorded the biggest increases in broadcast hours in 2008.

Free-to-air television key trends

- Total local content hours increased by 816 to 11,600 hours, a 7% increase on the previous year when 10,784 hours were broadcast. This is the highest level recorded to date and is largely due to increased News hours on TV One and TV3.
- The percentage of local content on the six main free-to-air channels rose to 34% of the schedule (32% in 2007).
- TV One screened the most local content, 3,954 hours. This is more than TV2, TV3 and Prime combined. MTS screened the second highest number of hours with 2,608 hours.
- Although Prime's local content increased, the channel screened the least: 817 hours.
- TV2 was the only channel to show a slight decrease in the total of local content hours, from 1,168 hours in 2007 to 1,110 hours in 2008.
- MTS screened the most local content in prime time with 902 hours, representing almost 30% of prime time schedule.
- C4's 1,136 hours of local content mainly consist of music videos.
- First-run hours, representing new series or new programmes, increased by 8.1% to 8,936 hours (8,225 hours in 2007) due to increases on four channels: TV One, TV3, C4 and MTS.

- TV One screened the most first-run local content (3,427 first-run hours). Next highest was TV3 (1,846 first-run hours), followed by MTS (1,243 first-run hours).
- Prime time local content hours decreased slightly to 3,701 (3,726 hours in 2007). This was mainly due to decreases on TV2, TV3 and Prime.
- Local content comprised 42.1% of prime time schedules, (42.5 % in 2007: 43.3% in 2006).
- Total hours of Children's programmes, Documentaries, Entertainment, News/Current Affairs and Sports increased, while Children's Drama, Information, and Drama/Comedy decreased. Māori programming for a general audience decreased on TV One.
- Children's programmes on MTS and TV3 contributed to the largest increase in total hours in that genre, from 837 hours in 2007 to 1,035 hours.
- Repeat screenings (2,664 hours) accounted for 23% of local content hours (24% in 2007). MTS screened the highest number of repeats.
- MTS and C4 have fewer total broadcast hours compared with the other channels, which accounts for their higher percentages of local content.

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2008 - Total Hours (by Channel)

This survey concentrates on the 18 hour clock (6am - midnight) unless specified.

Local content accounted for 34% (11,600 hours) of the total 6am - midnight broadcast hours across the six channels in 2008 (32% in 2007).

Excluding the smaller channels MTS, Prime and C4, the percentage is 36% compared with 33% in 2007. Results by channel follow:

TV One

- Total local content hours increased by 192 to 3,954 hours.
- Local content increased to 60% of the 6am midnight schedule (57.2% in 2007).
- TV One still screens more local content than any other channel, largely due to its News/ Current Affairs, Sports, Documentary and Entertainment outputs.
- TV One's figures reveal an increase of 187 hours of first-run or new programming, mainly in the News/Current Affairs, Sports and Entertainment genres (3,427 hours in 2008, 3,240 in 2007).
- In 2008 Documentary and Entertainment hours were up by 19 and 79 hours respectively.
- Drama/Comedy, Information and Māori programming hours decreased.

TV2

- TV2's local content hours dropped by 58 hours to 1,110, (1,168 in 2007; 1,300 in 2006).
- Local content made up 17% of the 6am to midnight schedule (18% in 2007; 20% in 2006).
- TV2 first-run hours were reduced by 66 hours (623 in 2008, 689 in 2007).
- Genres that increased were Drama/Comedy by 55 hours, and Information by 16 hours.
- The greatest decreases were seen in Children's (63 fewer hours), Children's Drama (14 fewer hours), Entertainment (41 fewer hours) and Documentaries (17 fewer hours).

TV3

- There was an increase of 391 hours of local content in 2008 reaching a total of 1,976 hours, (1,585 hours in 2007).
- Local content comprised 30% of the 6am midnight schedule (24% in 2007).
- TV3's first-run hours increased by 429 mainly due to increased News/Current Affairs, Children's and Information programmes (1,845 hours in 2008, 1,416 in 2007).
- A jump in News/Current Affairs first-run programming produced an extra 476 hours, new Children's programming increased by 32 hours, first-run Information by 12 hours, Māori programmes by five hours and Documentaries by four hours.
- Including repeated programmes, Children's programming increased by 40 hours, Documentaries by 17 hours, and Information by 25 hours.
- Total hours of Entertainment and Sports showed considerable decreases, down 80 and 75 hours respectively. Drama/Comedy decreased by 13 hours in 2008 when compared with 2007 figures.

- Total local content hours were 817 (760 in 2007).
- Local content was 12.3% of the 6am midnight schedule (11.5% in 2007).
- News/Current Affairs hours increased slightly to 195. Sports hours increased by 69 hours to a total of 545. There were 12 hours of Documentaries, 36 hours of Entertainment which represents an increase of 11 hours.
- The Information hours were down by 30 to 26 hours (56 in 2007).

C4

- In calculating local content hours on C4 an allowance of two hours per day is made for local music videos.
- Total local content hours were 1,136, almost all were music videos accounted for in Entertainment (1,031 in 2007).
- C4's first-runs local content hours increased by 205 (1,113 in 2008, 908 in 2007).
- Local content was 25% of the 6am midnight schedule.
- Entertainment hours are made up mainly of music videos: 1,108 in 2008, an increase of 91 hours.
- In 2008 there were nine hours of Documentary (one hour in 2007) and 18 Drama/Comedy hours, an increase of 10 hours.
- C4's free-to-air VHF schedule is the only platform we measure. C4 also transmits via a digital signal on Sky and Freeview with extended hours that are not measured in this survey.


Local Content 2008

MTS

- Total local content measured 2,608 hours, 131 more than the previous year.
- Local content keeps increasing on MTS comprising 83.5% of the 6am midnight schedule compared with 79.6% in 2007, (with average broadcast hours of 8.5 per day plus extended hours on Anzac Day).
- 44% of local content broadcast hours are repeated programmes.
- Overall MTS recorded a 10 hour increase in first-run programming, mainly seen in Documentaries, Entertainment and News/Current Affairs (1,243 hours in 2008, 1,233 in 2007).
- Children's programming reached 404 hours, an increase of 234 hours. Entertainment increased to 322 hours, up 126, and Documentary hours totalled 191, up 39 hours.
- Sports hours increased by 25 to 494.
- Decreases in local content hours were seen in two categories: Information dropped by 160 hours to 540 (700 in 2007). Drama/Comedy hours decreased by 136 to a total of 189 hours.

Main Variations by Genre

More detailed genre information is set out in section 8

In 2008 Children's programmes, Documentary, Entertainment, News/Current Affairs and Sports programming boosted the local content hours.

First-run hours increased, but only in the Entertainment and News/Current Affairs genres.

Although the total local content hours increased overall in 2008, decreases were seen in the hours of Children's Drama, Drama/Comedy, Information and Māori programming for general audiences.

- Children's programming continued to increase by 198 hours to 1035 hours (837 hours in 2007 and 785 in 2006).
- Children's Drama declined from 19 hours to 12 hours.
- Documentaries, which lost ground in 2007 picked up another 70 hours to reach 691 hours. TV One screened the most documentaries with 294 hours, 19 more than in 2007 but including 192 hours of repeats. TV2 screened 86 hours (17 fewer hours than in 2007). 27 hours were repeats. TV3 increased its hours from 82 to 99 (41 hours were repeats). Of Prime's 12 hours, eight were repeats. C4 screened nine hours in 2008, compared with one hour in 2007. MTS screened 191 hours, up from 152 hours in the previous year (120 hours were repeats).
- Drama/Comedy hours were down by 105 to total 711 hours (816 in 2007). TV One, TV3, Prime and MTS had less Drama/Comedy programming but TV2's hours were up by 55.
- Entertainment programming increased significantly to 1,808 hours mainly due to increases on MTS with a total of 322 hours (an extra 126), TV One 219 (an extra 79), C4 1,108 (an extra 91) and a smaller increase on Prime. TV2 and TV3's hours decreased by 41 and 80 respectively.
- The Information genre peaked in 2007 with 1,919 hours, a big increase over previous years but lost 211 hours in 2008 to total 1,708. There were increases on TV2 and TV3 but these were offset by 139 fewer hours on MTS in 2008.
- Māori programming for general audiences across three channels (excluding MTS) totalled 223
 hours, down from 308 hours in 2007. The biggest decline was on TV One which broadcast 94
 fewer hours. TV2 screened 24 hours (20 in 2007). Prime and C4 screened no Māori programmes
 in 2008.
- News/Current Affairs hours are up by 699 hours to a total of 3,660 (2,961 hours in 2007). Additional news programmes began on TV One and TV3 during 2007. TV3's hours increased by 479 hours, accounted for by a full year of the morning show *Sunrise*. TV One's hours increased by 214, with news programmes added to the schedule during 2007 running the full year in 2008. MTS hours remained the same on 469 hours (466 in 2007). Prime showed a small increase. C4 has no News/Current Affairs programmes.
- Sports hours were 1,754 (1,681 hours in 2007), with *The Olympics* and *The Paralympics* giving a boost to TV One. Its hours increased by 49 hours and TV3's hours decreased by 75. In the previous year TV3 had carried the *Rugby World Cup*.

First-run Hours

First-run hours are a significant local content indicator, reflecting the amount of new investment in New Zealand programmes. First-run hours include prime time (peak) and off-peak programming.

2008: 8,936 hours.

2007: 8,225 hours.

Total first-run hours went up by 711, representing an 8% increase.

First-run hours increased on TV One by 187 hours to 3,427 (3,240 in 2007).

TV2's first-run hours decreased by 67 to 622 hours.

TV3's hours increased by 430 to 1,846.

First-run hours were down on Prime by 54 to 685 hours.

C4's first-run hours increased by 205 to 1,113.

First-run hours on MTS went up by 10 hours from 1,233 to 1,243.

Excluding News/Current Affairs:

- TV One screened 27% first-run local content (27% in 2007)
- TV2 screened 9% first-run local content (10% in 2007)
- TV3 screened 9% first-run local content (10% in 2007)
- Prime screened 7% first-run local content (8.5% in 2007)
- C4 screened 24% first-run local content (20% in 2007). C4 screens no News/Current Affairs programmes.
- MTS screened 32% first-run local content (32% in 2007)

Changes to note in 2008 include:

- Children's first-run programming, including Children's Drama decreased slightly from 538 hours to 528. But TV3 and MTS increased their first-run hours by 32 and 24 hours respectively. TV2, the main broadcaster for Children's programming, dropped its hours by 63 to 251 first-run hours. In 2008 TV2, the only broadcaster carrying first-run Children's Drama, screened four hours, down from nine hours in 2007.
- Documentary first-run hours remain almost the same: 302 in 2008; 299 in 2007. Increases on TV3, C4 and MTS, offset the losses on TV One (14 fewer hours), TV2 (18 fewer hours) and Prime (four fewer hours).
- Drama/Comedy took a hit with 106 fewer first-run hours: 245 first-run hours in 2008 (351 in 2007). Most of the hours were lost from MTS (82 fewer hours), TV One (31 fewer hours), five each from TV3 and Prime. Only TV2 and C4 reported an increase: six hours and nine hours respectively.
- Entertainment hours, which decreased in 2007 showed a dramatic increase in first-run hours, up 240 hours to 1,511 in 2008. TV One's total first-run Entertainment hours reached 151 hours, an increase of 82 hours, and MTS screened an extra 49 hours to reach 145. The major increase was on C4, with an extra 195 hours, bringing the total to 1,093.
- Total first-run local Information hours were 1,386 (1,474 in 2007). Four channels showed a decrease in first-run Information hours, but TV2 had a 41 hour increase and TV3 a 12 hour increase. TV One's first-run Information programming was down by 65 hours and MTS had a 42 hour decrease.
- Māori Programmes for general audiences showed a 45 hour decrease. (We do not record this
 category for MTS: 'Māori programmes' on MTS are distributed across all the genres.) TV3
 increased its hours by five to a total of 43. TV One screened 125 first-run hours. TV2's hours
 increased by four to 24 hours. Prime and C4 have no programmes in this genre.
- First-run News/Current Affairs hours increased by 723 hours to 3,364 hours due to a full year of new programmes on TV One and TV3 that began part-way through 2007.
- Sports hours decreased by five hours. Increases on TV One (*The Olympics*) and TV2 offset the decreases on TV3 and Prime.

NZ On Air's contribution to first-run hours was 18% (19 % in 2007). Excluding MTS, Prime and C4 the figure is 12% (13% in 2007, 14% in 2006).

Details on first-run local content for each channel follow:

TV One

- First-run local content hours increased by 187 to 3,427 hours.
- First-run local content represents 52% of TV One's schedule (6am midnight).
- The greatest increase in first-run hours was in News/Current Affairs by 204 hours. The total was 1,656 hours.
- News Specials covering Elections here and in the USA, and NZI Business added extra hours in the News/Current Affairs genre.
- Entertainment hours increased by 81 hours. New and returning programmes, *Stars in Their Eyes, Wheel of Fortune* and *Who Wants to be a Millionaire?* accounted for increases in the genre.
- Sports hours increased by 64: The Olympics and The Paralympics contributed to the increase.
- Information first-run hours were down by 65 hours to 816; first-run Drama/Comedy hours decreased from 62 hours in 2007 to 31 in 2008, but included the new series *Burying Brian*.
- Māori programmes decreased by 53 to 125 hours. The 2008 series of Marae reduced from one hour to 30 minutes and The Olympics pre-empted the screening of other regular Māori programmes.
- Documentary hours decreased by 14 to a total of 102. New series included NZ Festival, Beyond the Darklands and Off the Radar.

TV2

- TV2's first-run local content hours showed a decline of 67 hours, across five of the nine genres. The total was 622 hours (689 in 2007).
- First-run local content programming accounted for 9% of TV2's schedule (10% in 2007).
- Information had a boost of 41 extra hours bringing the total to 71 hours in 2008, including new programmes *Trade Wars* and *Home Sick*.
- Māori programming had a four hour boost with *Korero Mai Speak to Me* bringing the first-run hours to 24.
- Drama/Comedy showed an increase of six hours and Sports increased by four hours, which included the new *International Netball Series*.
- The biggest decreases in local content first-run hours were: Children's Programming with 63 fewer hours, Documentaries with 19 fewer hours and Entertainment with 33 fewer hours.

TV3

- First-run local content hours increased by 430 hours to 1,846 hours.
- The percentage of first-run hours broadcast increased from 22% in 2007 to 28% in 2008.
- The biggest increase was in News/Current Affairs with 476 extra hours of first-run programming,

due to the full year of Sunrise and Newsday: 3 News at 12. New series included ASB Business and Decision 08.

- Four other genres showed an increase: Children's Programmes by 32 hours to a total of 154 hours, including the new series *Action Central*; Information by 12 hours to 98 hours; Māori programmes up five to 43 hours, and Documentaries up four hours to 58. New Documentary series included *What's Really in our Food?* and *The Lost Boys*.
- Genres to see decreases were Drama/Comedy, Entertainment and Sports. New Comedy series included *The Jaquie Brown Diaries, A Thousand Apologies* and *The Millen Baird Show*.
- Entertainment first-run hours were down by 42 hours to 71; and Sports down 53 hours to a total of 148.

Prime


- Prime's first-run local content hours were down by 54 hours in 2008, to a total of 685 hours.
- 10% of the schedule was devoted to first-run programming (11% in 2007).
- News/Current Affairs showed a 12 hour increase in first-run programming with Campaign 08.
- Information first-run local content hours decreased from 51 hours in 2007 to 23 in 2008.
- Entertainment decreased by 11 hours; Drama/Comedy clocked up a total of four hours with the *Wayne Anderson: Glory Days* series.
- Rugby, cricket and league dominated the Sports schedule with first-run programmes e.g
 Twenty20 Cricket, Rugby League NRL and *Rugby: Air NZ Cup.* However there were 19 fewer
 hours in this genre in 2008.

C4

- First-run local content was 1,113 hours on C4 in 2008, an increase of 205 hours, representing 25% of the schedule.
- Entertainment was up by 195 hours on the channel that screens mostly musical content in the *Homegrown* series and *The Official NZ Top 40*.
- Drama/Comedy increased by nine hours to a total of 13 hours with shows like *The World According to Bro'Town* and *Back of the Y*.
- C4 had six hours of first-run Documentaries, including Rocked the Nation.

MTS

- First-run local content was 1,243, an increase of 10 hours.
- First-run programming represented 40% of the schedule, the same as in 2007.
- News/Current Affairs increased by 29 hours.
- Entertainment first-run hours increased by 49; Documentary hours increased by 31 reaching a total of 74 first-run hours. Documentaries included *Breaking the Boundaries: A Māori Violinist in China* and *The Navy and the Treaty*.



Prime Time Hours

Prime time represents the hours between 6pm - 10pm seven days a week. As 2008 was a leap year, prime time hours across six channels were 8,784.

During these four hours, all the networks compete to attract the greatest number of viewers, to generate maximum income. The bulk of their commissioning budgets is spent in this time band. Therefore prime time local content hours are a useful indicator of the status of production spending by the television networks.

Total prime time local content hours in 2008 were down 25 hours to 3,701 (3,726 in 2007). This represented 42.1% of the prime time schedule (42.5%, in 2007; 43.3% in 2006).

For TV One, TV2 and TV3 prime time local content totalled 1,752 compared with 1,763 hours in 2007 and 1,818 hours in 2006.

- TV One's prime time local content increased from 819 to 843 hours. Documentaries and News/Current Affairs increased by 11 hours in each genre; Sports increased by 45 hours; Drama/Comedy decreased by 15 hours; Entertainment showed little change from 2007; and there were 25 fewer Information hours in prime time.
- TV2's total prime time local content hours were 279, down from 295 in 2007. Documentaries decreased by five hours; Entertainment decreased by 22 hours; Information increased by 10 hours and there was no change in News/Current Affairs.
- TV3's prime time local content hours decreased by 19 hours from 649 in 2007 to 630 in 2008. Documentaries were up six hours and Information increased by four hours. There were eight extra News/Current Affairs hours. Drama/Comedy decreased by five hours and Entertainment decreased by 23 hours. Sports dropped completely from the prime time schedule (10 hours in 2007).
- Prime's prime time hours decreased from 246 in 2007 to 218 in 2008. Small decreases were seen in Documentaries, Drama/Comedy, Entertainment, and Information.
- MTS screened the most hours of local content in prime time: 902 hours, the same as in 2007.
- C4's prime time hours reached 829, an increase of 15 hours, almost all of which are music videos (810 hours).

- TV One screened 21% local content in prime time (20% in 2007).
- TV2 screened 18% local content (19% in 2007).
- TV3 screened 8% local content (10% in 2007).
- Prime screened 15% local content (17% in 2007). Prime's news bulletins screen outside 6pm
 10pm prime time hours.
- MTS screened 44% local content (47% in 2007).
- C4 screened 57% local content (56% in 2007). C4 has no News/Current Affairs programmes.

Details of prime time local content on each channel follows:

TV One

- TV One screened 843 hours of prime time local content an increase of 24 hours when compared with 2007.
- Prime time Documentaries increased by 11 hours.
- News/Current Affairs hours increased by 11 hours in prime time.
- Sports increased by 45 hours in prime time.
- Drama/Comedy decreased by 15 hours and Entertainment hours remained constant on a total of 64 hours; Information hours in prime time were down on the previous year by 25 hours.

TV2

- Local content in prime time decreased by 16 hours to 279 in 2008.
- Documentaries decreased by six hours.
- Drama/Comedy increased by four hours in prime time.
- Entertainment hours in prime time decreased by 22 hours to 35 hours and Information decreased from 69 hours to a total of 30 hours in 2008.
- News/Current Affairs remained the same on a total of 13 hours in prime time.

TV3

- Prime time local content totalled 630 hours a decline of 19 hours when compared with 2007.
- Documentaries increased by six hours to reach 48 hours.
- Drama/Comedy decreased by four hours to 30 hours, Entertainment decreased by 23 to 13 hours in prime time.
- Information increased by four hours to 25 hours and News/Current Affairs went up by eight. In 2008 there was no Sports programming on TV3 in prime time.

- Prime time local content decreased by 28 hours in 2008 to 218 hours.
- Sports hours in prime time accounted for the biggest share at 184 hours, almost the same as in 2007.
- Prime screened four hours of both Documentary and Drama/Comedy in prime time.
- Entertainment hours in prime time decreased by eight hours to 13 hours and Information decreased by 14 hours to a total of 13 hours in prime time.


C4

- Prime time local content on C4 totalled 829 hours (814 hours in 2007).
- Entertainment hours accounted for the biggest share at 810 hours.
- The balance was made up of Drama/Comedy (13 hours) and Documentary (six).

MTS

- MTS screened 902 prime time local content hours in 2008, the same as in 2007 and again more than any other channel.
- News/Current Affairs totalled 258 hours, an increase of 42 hours.
- Documentaries increased by 26 hours to 62 hours and Entertainment by 31 hours to 117 hours.
- Information programming dropped in 2008 by 44 hours to 313 hours.
- The biggest decrease was in Drama/Comedy which dropped from 99 hours in prime time in 2007 to 14 hours.
- Sports programming increased by 27 hours.

Extended Prime Time

This section is added at the request of the networks, which work to "extended prime time", between 5:30pm and 11pm.

News/Current Affairs programmes make up the bulk of the local content programmes screened during these hours.

TV One

TV One screened an additional 287 hours in the extended period: 122 in News/Current Affairs, 88 in Entertainment, 44 in Sports; 25 in Information, four in Documentary, and four in Drama/Comedy.

TV2

TV2 screened five hours - all in Drama/Comedy.

TV3

TV3 screened 205 hours in the extended time: 124 hours of News/Current Affairs, 51 hours of Sports, 17 hours of Information and 13 hours of Entertainment programming.

Prime

Prime screened 201 hours in the extended period, of which 194 were News/Current Affairs. The balance was made up of seven Sports hours.

C4

Entertainment programming accounted for 46 extended prime time hours screened on C4.

MTS

MTS screened a further 767 hours: 43 in Information, 13 in Entertainment, five in Documentary, four in Sports and two hours of Children's programming.

Repeat Hours

The requirement for repeat programming is driven in part by the demands of 24-hour transmission, (the need to screen low-cost programming in less commercial slots, such as overnight or very early morning.) It is also an efficient use of commissioned programmes. Repeat screenings are generally used at no cost to the channel. In their contracts with the networks, production companies agree to a number of repeat screenings of their programmes, within a certain time frame.

Some programmes, such as various Children's programmes, are designed to be repeated and have a long shelf life to serve new generations of young audiences.


Repeated programmes do not feature frequently in prime time except over summer holidays. In this report, repeat hours are measured against the 18 hour clock, from 6am - midnight, the most-watched period of the TV schedule.

In 2008, repeat screenings across six channels totalled 2,664 hours, an increase of 106 hours. Repeat hours comprised 23% of total local content hours (24% in 2007).

Repeat screenings on TV One, TV2 and TV3 only, totalled 1,145 hours compared with 1,170 in 2007 and 997 hours in 2006.

- TV One repeated 527 hours of local content (523 in 2007). This represents 8% of the 18 hour schedule. The increases occurred in Documentary by 34 hours, Drama/Comedy by 12 hours and Information and News/Current Affairs by eight hours respectively. These increases were offset by a reduction in repeated local content hours in Māori Programmes and Sports.
- Repeats increased on TV2 by nine hours, to a total of 488 hours. This represents 7% of the schedule. Drama/Comedy comprised 233 hours of repeated programming (184 in 2007). 224 hours of Children's programming were repeated in 2007 and in 2008.
- Overall repeats on TV3 were down by 39 hours, making a total of 130 hours (169 in 2007). This represents 2% of their broadcast schedule. Documentaries and Information had increases of 12 and 13 hours respectively.
- Prime screened 132 hours of repeated local content (21 hours in 2007). 98 hours were repeated Sports programming.
- MTS repeated 1,365 hours, comprising 44% of their broadcast hours. Children's programming showed the biggest increase with 211 extra hours of repeats. Entertainment had 76 extra hours.
- C4's repeat local programming was 23 hours (123 hours in 2007). The repeat hours were mostly in Entertainment.





Trends by Genre

A brief summary of the 2008 trends in each genre is listed below. Statistics for the nine genres by channel are in Appendix 2.

Children's Programmes (including Children's Drama)

The total hours for Children's Programmes, including Children's Drama, increased by 191 hours in 2008 to reach 1047 (856 in 2007).

TV2's Children's hours decreased by 77 hours and TV3's hours increased by 33. But the major increase was on MTS with a total of 404 hours, an increase of 234 hours. MTS increased its first-run Children's programming hours from 94 in 2007 to 118 hours in 2008.

No Children's programming screened on TV One or Prime.


TV2 is the main broadcaster of locally made Children's programmes with a total of 475 hours (538 hours in 2007). TV2's first-run hours decreased by 63 hours to 251 hours. Repeats were 224 hours. New programmes to engage young viewers were *Activate*, *I Am TV*, and *Zip & Mac*. Back for another series were *The Go Show Weekend*, *Just the Job, Let's Get Inventin'*, *Studio 2*, the ever popular *What Now?* and *Stage Challenge*. *The Killian Curse* returned as did *Amazing Extraordinary Friends* and *Karaoke High. Jane and the Dragon* and *Hard Out* were repeated dramas. Children's Drama accounted for five hours on TV2. Locally made Children's Drama, only found on TV2 and TV3, is an important genre for NZ On Air.

Children's programming on TV3 increased by 25 hours to 155 (129 in 2007). First-run programmes accounted for 154 hours of the total. *Action Central, Bryan and Bobby* and the popular part-animated series, *The Simon Eliot Show*, as well as other favourites, *Sticky TV*, *Small Blacks TV* and *Smokefree Rockquest* all returned with new series in 2008. *Love to Sing* is a popular repeat.

MTS screened 404 hours of Children's programming, a significant increase in 2008 (170 hours in 2007). There were further series of *Tau Ke: Manu Rere*, the Māori language series and *Pukana* screened, after first screening on TV3.

Because Children's programming screens in off-peak (non-commercial) timeslots, broadcasters do not usually commission this genre without substantial financial assistance. NZ On Air is the main funding contributor to this genre committing over \$11 million to Children's Drama in the 2007/08 financial year.





Documentaries

TV One and MTS are the channels that screened most New Zealand documentaries in 2008. Including repeated programmes, Documentary hours on the six free-to-air channels increased in 2008: a total of 691 hours were recorded (621 in 2007). NZ On Air research surveys always rate Documentary as a favourite genre.

TV One screened 294 hours of local documentary of which 193 hours were repeat screenings.

92 hours screened in prime time, and included the following series: Beyond the Darklands, Undercover, Brain Power, Off The Radar, Under Investigation; a series of medical mysteries, and Animal House, which screened previously on TV3. Five programmes of the New Zealand Festival Series screened early in the New Year on Saturday nights and were repeated on Sunday mornings; The Boy from Island Bay, The Last Western Heretic, A Tall, Long Faced Tale, Deer Wars and the award-winning programme, The Nuclear Comeback.

Returning favourites included *Country Calendar* (now into its 43rd year and thought to be the longest running series in the world after Coronation Street), *Piha Rescue, Intrepid Journeys, Location, Location, Location and the valued Artsville* series.

TV2 screened 60 of its 86 documentary hours in prime time. *Trade Wars* and *Matthew & Marc's Rocky Road to Russia* featured as new series. Returning series were *Sensing Murder, The Lion Man, Serious Crash Unit* and *Neighbours at War*.

TV3's local documentary hours increased from 82 to 99 hours; 48 hours played in prime time and 41 hours were repeats. *Inside New Zealand* returned with a number of one-off programmes, including the award-winning *Murder in the Pacific, as well as The Secret of John Rowles* and *A Good Way To Die?* New series included the three part programme *The Lost Boys, What's Really in Our Food?* and *The Kitchen Job.* New series of *Wa\$ted* and *Money Man* returned. *Aftershock: Would You Survive?* proved popular with viewers.


Prime screened 12 hours of documentary in 2008. The four part *Captain Cook: Obsession and Discovery* screened in prime time. The remaining eight hours were repeat screenings of *NZ's Top 100 History Makers*.

C4 expanded its documentary repertoire with nine hours in 2008 (one hour in 2007). This was accounted for by the series *Rocked The Nation*, which the channel also repeated.

MTS increased its documentary hours by 39 to 191 hours, 62 playing in prime time. There was an increase of 31 hours of first-run documentaries which included *God and Guns, The Navy and The Treaty, Breaking The Boundaries: A Māori Violinist in China, Nga Waiata o te Iwi,* and Anzac Day documentaries, *Turangaarere: The Story of John Pohe,* and *Po ki te Po: Night After Night.*

NZ On Air is a substantial supporter of the Documentary genre and committed over \$12 million in the 2007 - 2008 financial year (\$10 million in the 2006-2007 year). This contributes to approximately 123 hours of New Zealand documentary programming.





Drama/Comedy Hours

There was a drop of 105 hours for Drama/Comedy in 2008 (711 hours compared with 816 in 2007).

Of the six free-to-air channels only TV2 increased its hours, from 324 hours in 2007 to 379 hours in 2008. MTS, the other main channel featuring Drama/Comedy dropped its hours by 136, screening 189 hours in 2008. Drama and Comedy are regarded as challenging genres to launch.

TV One's total hours of local Drama/Comedy programming went from 93 to 74 hours.

TV3's hours decreased from 62 to 48 and Prime from seven to four hours.

TV One screened a new series of *The Pretender* and *The Unauthorised History of New Zealand. Rude Awakenings* and *Good Hands* were repeated. *Burying Brian* was the only new drama.

TV2 screened 146 hours of first-run programming. *Moon TV Network* and 2 *Tube* are new comedies and an *Eating Media Lunch Special* screened in 2008. Among the 233 hours of repeats are the popular *Comedy Innovation Series, Eating Media Lunch* and *The Comedy Pilots*.

Shortland Street continued its successful run. The now internationally acclaimed bro'Town was back for another season. During the year Insiders Guide to Love, Savage Honeymoon and Shortland Street Omnibus were repeated.


TV3 local Drama/Comedy hours reached 48, of which 30 played in prime time. *Outrageous Fortune* series four defies history with its outrageously successful run. New comedies included *The Jaquie Brown Diaries* – an instant hit – and *A Thousand Apologies*, a comedy with an Asian flavour and *The Millen Baird Show*.

Prime screened four hours of cult series Wayne Anderson: Glory Days.

C4 screened 18 hours of Drama/Comedy, including the comedy, *Back Of The Y, The World According to bro'Town* and the movie *The Frighteners*.

MTS had 18 hours of first-run programmes in this genre, a major drop from 2007. The total was 189 hours of which 171 were repeats. New programmes consisted of a series of *Table Plays* and the *Anzac Short Film Festival*. Repeats included *Pictures, Kai Korero Jubilee* and the film *Stickmen*.





Entertainment

The Entertainment genre saw a leap in the number of hours in 2008. Locally-made Entertainment hours increased by 187 to 1,808 hours in 2008 (1,621 hours in 2007). The hours increased on TV One, Prime, C4 and MTS and were offset by significant decreases on TV2 and TV3.

Entertainment programming increased on TV One by 79 hours to 219 hours (140 hours in 2007). First-run programming increased by 82 hours to a total of 151 first-run hours, 64 hours of which played in prime time. Off peak and repeat programming account for the remaining hours. Entertainment hours were backed up by format shows e.g. Wheel of Fortune, Stars in their Eyes, Who Wants to be a Millionaire? and now in its fourth season Dancing With The Stars. The Rich List and Game of Two Halves returned and Mitre 10 Jack of All Trades and Stars in their Eyes were among the repeats.

Olympic specials e.g. Beijing 2008: Opening Ceremony, are included in TVNZ Entertainment figures.

TV2's Entertainment hours decreased to 40 hours from 81 in 2007. First-run hours totalled 38 hours, down from 71 in 2007. *The Singing Bee* and *Dare to Win* were two new competitive shows and *Lotto* and *Sportscafe* were returning series. In the repeats: *The Mo Show, Mike King's Adults Only,* and *Guess Who's Coming to Dinner?*

TV3's Entertainment hours decreased from 164 to 84 hours in 2008. First-run programming decreased from 113 hours in 2007 to 71 in 2008. *Joker Poker* and *Deal Or No Deal* returned for second series and *The Official NZ Top 40* and *Celebrity Joker Poker* were again popular shows. The Qantas Film & Television Awards and AotearoHA – The Billy T Awards also screened on TV3.

Local Entertainment programming on Prime increased again in 2008 by 12 hours (14 hour increase in 2007) to reach a total of 36 hours. 13 hours screened in prime time, but the remaining 23 hours were repeated programmes. New Zealand's Got Talent was a new series and Bassline was repeated.

C4's locally produced Entertainment hours increased by 91 hours to 1,108, (1,017 hours in 2007.) C4's Entertainment programming represents 97% of local content hours for this music-oriented channel.


An allowance of 2 hours per day is made for local music videos screened on C4. In addition to this C4 screened *Homegrown* and *The Official NZ Top 40*, (also played on TV3.) *Video Hits: VNZMA 2008 Finalists, 48 Hours 2008, Jono's New Show, The World According to bro' Town* and *Rocked the Nation* also screened on C4.

MTS screened 322 hours of Entertainment programming, an increase of 126 hours when compared with 2007 (196 hours in 2007). 117 hours screened in prime time and there were 176 hours of repeat programming.

MTS endeavours to cover a huge range of events and activities for their viewers from national award programmes e.g. 2008 Māori Media Awards to Whānau Christmas Show. A wide range of programmes screened, including LIPS (Locked Into Pacific Sound), Homai Te Pakipaki, Sealord Opera in the Park, Kete Aronui, Vodafone One Tribe, Kaihoe Wahine, and Māorioke Show.

NZ On Air does not generally fund programmes in the Entertainment genre, as they tend to be lower cost and/or sufficiently commercial for broadcasters to fund them independently.





Information Programming

Information, the genre with the largest increase in locally produced programmes in 2007, slipped from the top spot in 2008. Information hours decreased from 1,919 hours to 1,708 hours, a drop of 211 hours.

TV One continued to screen most local Information programming with a total of 924 hours, representing 56 fewer hours. Only 44 hours screened in prime time, the bulk in off-peak hours. Programming included *Sir Edmund Hillary, 1919 to 2008, State Funeral* and returning series included *Hunger for the Wild, Rural Delivery, Kiwi Kitchen,* and special interest series, *My God, Tagata Pasifika, Asia Downunder,* the disabilities series *Attitude,* and the long time favourite *Fair Go.*

TV2 increased its Information programming by 16 hours with a total of 71 hours, 30 of which screened in prime time. Programmes included *The Truth Files, Police Ten-7* and *Home Sick*.

TV3's local Information hours increased by 25 to 148 hours. Half the programmes screened in off-peak slots; 25 hours screened in prime time and 50 hours were repeated shows. New series included *The Big Stuff*, and *ITM Fishing Show*. Returning programmes were *Target*, *Open Door* and *Pacific Beat Street*.


Prime had 30 fewer hours of Information programming in 2008, reaching a total of 26 hours (56 hours in 2007,) with an even split between prime time and off-peak screenings. New shows included NZ Open Homes and Precision Automobiles Alfa Romeo Speed Machine. Returning series were AA Torque Show, Black Magic Fishing NZ and Getaway NZ.

C4 screened no Information programmes in 2008 (6 hours in 2007).

MTS screened 540 hours of Information programming (700 hours in 2007). Almost 60% screened in prime time. Programming included the comprehensive Anzac Day coverage, the *Indigenous Broadcasters Conference* and *Waitangi 2008*. Programme titles include *Matatahi, Warrant of Fitness* and *Whatukura*. Returning series include *Haa, Marae DIY, Tu Te Puehu* and *Kai Time*.

NZ On Air provided funding support for several shows in the Information category, notably special interest programming such as *Attitude, Asia Downunder, My God, Tagata Pasifika, Rural Delivery, Anzac Day 2008*, and *Praise Be* on TV One; and *The Truth Files* on TV2. It also provided funding for TV3's *Pacific Beat Street* and *Open Door*.





Māori Programming

The total hours of Māori programming for a general audience decreased from 308 hours in 2007 to 223 in 2008. (All programmes on MTS are classified by genre e.g. Documentary, Comedy/Drama, Information etc.)

TV One's Māori programming hours decreased by 94 hours to a total of 156 hours (250 hours in 2007). This is partly attributed to the reduction of *Marae* from a series of one hour programmes to half hour programmes in 2008. During the Olympic Games *Te Karere* was shortened and *Whānau* removed from the schedule. Other programmes on TV One were *Waka Huia* and *Marae Summer Season*.


TV2 screened 24 hours in 2008 (20 hours in 2007). Programmes included Korero Mai - Speak to Me.

TV3's total hours for Māori programming increased from 38 to 43 hours in 2008. *Tu Te Puehu* and *Pukana* accounted for the bulk of the programming.

All Māori programming on TV One, TV2 and TV3 screened off-peak. No Māori programmes screened on Prime or C4.

MTS screened *Waka Huia* and *Marae*, which screened first on TV One. *Pukana*, classified under the Children's genre for MTS, and *Tu Te Puehu*, classified as Information on MTS, screened first on TV3 as Māori programming.

Māori Broadcasting funding agency Te Māngai Pāho funds the majority of Māori programming, much of which is in te Reo and often subtitled. NZ On Air contributes funding to Māori programmes considered to be of interest to a mainstream audience including Māori, and usually in English.



News/Current Affairs

News/Current Affairs programming increased in 2008 to reach an all time high of 3,660 hours (2,961 hours in 2007). The increase is partly accounted for by new programmes that were launched in 2007, running for a full year. 2008 was also Election Year.

TV One's News hours increased by 213 from 1525 hours recorded in 2007, to 1739 hours. TV One's news programmes are *One News at Midday, One News at 4.30pm, News at 6pm*, (the cornerstone of TV One's schedule and the start of prime time,) and the late night programme, *One News Tonight*. Off-peak News/Current Affairs increased by 193 hours and repeat hours increased by eight.

ASB Business and Breakfast are repackaged for weekend transmission. Returning series included Agenda, the Saturday morning Current Affairs programme that moved part way through the year to Sunday morning, Breakfast Business, Close Up, Sunday, and Eye To Eye.

Extended specials included: *Breakfast Special: Sir Edmund Hillary State Funeral* and two *One News Specials: Gallipoli* and *The Budget*. The General Election added hours to this genre: *Opening Addresses, One News: YouTube Election, One News Election 08 Leaders*, and from the States: *One News Special, America Decides*.

TV2's total hours decreased by two hours, to 13 hours, all of which screen in prime time. These hours are represented by the Current Affairs show 20/20, which screens on Wednesday nights.


TV3's hours increased by the biggest margin to reach 1,244 hours an increase of 479 hours. This is partly due to the new programmes in 2007, *Sunrise, Newsday* and 3 *News at 12*, running for a full year. *Campbell Live* returned five nights a week as did the late news *Nightline* and the weekly 60 *Minutes*. Added features were the 60 *Minutes Summer Special*, *Decision 08: The Defining Debate* and the five and a half hour *Election Special*.

Prime's News/Current Affairs programming increased slightly to 195 hours, partly due to *The Prime News Global Warming Special* and election coverage in *Campaign 08. Prime News* sceens at 5.30pm.

No local News/Current Affairs programming screened on C4.

MTS News/Current Affairs accounted for 469 of the total hours, about the same as in 2007. *Te Kāea* anchored the News schedule. Other programming included *Native Affairs, Te Heteri, Te Tepu* and *Eye to Eye*, which screens first on TV One. A Māori Television Special included *Native Affairs: Bastion Point 30th Commemorative*. There was an increase of 29 first-run News/Current Affairs hours and a 27 hour increase in repeat programming.

NZ On Air does not generally contribute funding to News/Current Affairs programmes.



Sports

International sporting events in four year cycles, such as the Olympic Games (1992, 1996, 2000, 2004, and 2008), Commonwealth Games (1990, 1994, 1998, 2002 and 2006), the America's Cup (1995, 1999, 2003 and 2007) or the Rugby World Cup scheduled next for New Zealand in 2011, can cause total sports coverage to fluctuate dramatically from year to year.

In Olympic Games year, 2008, the total of sports hours reached 1,754 an increase of 73 hours when compared with 2007 (1,681 in 2007).

TV One secured the rights to the Olympics and the Paralympics in China and increased their hours to 549. Almost all those hours screened in off-peak times. TV One also scored the rights to the *World IRB 7s Series, Surf League, NZ Ocean Swim Series*, and a line up of women's sports: *One Sport Netball ANZ Series, New World International Netball Series* and the *Fifa Women's Under 17 World Cup*.

Popular returning programmes were *Powerbuilt Tools Motorsport, One Sport IRB 7's*, as well as *ASB Classic Women's Tennis 2008* and the *Heineken Open Men's Tennis. Action Replay Ski Season* featured in the repeated programming.

TV2 Sports hours measure 18 hours in total, all screening in off-peak time slots. Two games in the *International Netball Series* featured New Zealand. *Surf Club 174*, and *NZ Performance Car TV* were returning series. There was also a series of *Beach Volleyball*.


TV3 clocked up 148 hours over the year dropping its hours from 223 in 2007 to 148 in 2008, almost all programming playing in off peak slots. New programmes included NZ V8 Ute Series and the spectacular Snowboarding: Global Open Series from Lake Wanaka. Hyundai Sports Tonight is a popular segment after Nightline and returning shows were ING Golf Club, Pulp Sport, 3 Sport Arena, 3 Sport Rugby, 3 Sport Jet Sprints, and V8 Supercars.

Prime's local sports hours were up from 476 hours to 545 hours. Prime featured mainly cricket and rugby. New series included Super 14 Rugby, The Air New Zealand Cup, Rugby International: ABs v Wallabies and Hong Kong Retravision Rugby. The NRL Rugby League NRL series returned.

In cricket, Prime scored the *One Day Series: England v NZ, 2020 Cricket*, and the NZ-UK Test, as well as *State Shield Cricket*. Returning series were *The Crowd Goes Wild* and *Toyota Grassroots Rugby*.

There were no Sports hours on C4.

MTS increased its Sports hours by 25, with a total of 494 hours. First-run programmes accounted for 252 hours; 242 hours were repeats. *Rugby League World Cup* played on MTS, (all games were in Australia.) Returning series were *Hyundai Code* and *Boil Up Reheated*. Basketball series, including *Breakers v Melbourne Tigers*, the 2008 National Waka AMA Club Sprint Championships, and the National Touch Series were some of the sports covered by MTS.



Pay TV, Regional Channels & Freeview Channels: TVNZ 6 & 7

NZ On Air collates the data in the main body of this report. But local content data from Pay TV, Regional channels and for the first time data from the digital channels TVNZ 6 and TVNZ 7, is supplied by the respective broadcasters and is unverified.

Sky Television

Figures for local content screened on pay television channels operated by Sky are collated and provided to NZ On Air for this report (see appendix 9.) This data is not independently verified by NZ On Air.

According to the information supplied by Sky total local content measured 44,684 hours, of which 29,504 hours were music videos often repeated on the Juice channels. The total includes Prime's local content hours and TV3's News bulletins translated in Chinese and Korean. Sports hours accounted for 9,546 hours of the total.

Documentaries replayed on the Documentary channel increased from 236 hours in 2007 to 871 hours in 2008.

Regional Channels

Over the past fifteen years, regional television broadcasting has been playing an increasingly significant role in the country's broadcast tapestry.

Channels are spread from Kaitaia to Invercargill, each reflecting the nature of the local communities they serve.

Content varies from region to region depending on requirements, from the diverse cross-cultural content of Auckland's Triangle Television, which is arguably the country's most ethnically diverse broadcaster, to the more localised rural content of those channels in smaller centres.

The method of reporting regional output differs to mainstream in that in addition to programming that is made by the channel itself there is often a substantial amount of original programming. This is sourced directly from the community or from other channels, resulting in the "locally provided" report field while in some cases programming is repeated on a regular basis.

In 2008 approximately 26,000 hours of local content played on 13 regional channels round the country. First run locally made and locally provided programmes represented 6,696 hours of the total local content hours.

TVNZ 6 & TVNZ 7

TVNZ's digital channels, TVNZ 6 and TVNZ 7, are advertising-free public service channels funded by the government and broadcast on the Freeview platform.

TVNZ 6 launched on 30 September 2007 and has programming divided across three services: TVNZ Kidzone, TVNZ Family and TVNZ Showcase. A significant amount of local content is screened with 64% across all transmission hours and 77% in prime time in 2008. New local content featuring on the channel includes: Kidzone, in beTWEEN, Meet The Locals, Animal Academy, New Artland, The Gravy and Talk Talk. The channel also showcases works by New Zealand's up-and-coming film makers.

TVNZ 7 launched in March 2008 with a live political debate in Parliament between the minor party leaders. New Zealand's first local factual channel, TVNZ 7 features news - with 10 minute bulletins on the hour and an hour long evening bulletin - documentaries, current affairs and commentary shows. The channel features 80% local content. *Back Benches*, a political commentary show hosted by Wallace Chapman, and *Media7*, a media review and commentary show hosted by Russell Brown, are among the local commissions for the channel.

10 Notes On Methodology

- For the six free-to-air channels, data from the *Listener* programme billings is recorded onto an
 Access database. Scheduling changes by the television networks after *New Zealand Listener*publication are generally not included; nor are unlisted programmes such as short filler
 programmes.
- 2. Programmes have, in most cases, been counted according to the amount of New Zealand content within the programme. For example, series such as 20/20 which averages two overseas stories and one New Zealand-produced story per episode, have been recorded as containing one-third of an hour of New Zealand content (two thirds in the case of 60 Minutes). There is a degree of arbitrariness to such allocations, but the emphasis is on consistency so trends can be observed.
- 3. Sports programmes are the main example of programmes that fluctuate significantly, and the New Zealand content is not always published in detail in advance. For accuracy Sports programmes would have to be timed as they go to air. As this is not practicable for NZ On Air, all sports content included within New Zealand-produced branded programmes has been counted as a New Zealand programme. For sports matches not featuring a New Zealand team, but which include a New Zealand commentator "topping and tailing" the broadcast, an allowance is made for the presenter links only.
- 4. If a programme straddles prime time and off-peak, it is counted as prime time if the majority of the programme screens in prime time. For example, if a programme begins screening at 9.15pm and concludes at 10.15pm, it is counted as one hour of prime time.
- 5. In general, programmes are counted as whole hours or half hours irrespective of the differing durations often encountered. For example, a programme may actually have a duration of between 22 minutes and 29 minutes, depending on the length of advertising and promotion breaks, but is counted as a full half-hour for simplicity.
- 6. First-run programmes mean programmes that are appearing on a free-to-air national network for the first time. If a programme screened on C4 first, and was then repeated on TV3, the latter screenings are counted as a repeat. Previous screenings on pay television are not counted.
- 7. New Zealand content is classified as material which is both predominantly made in New Zealand and which reflects New Zealand identity and culture. Thus programmes which are made in New Zealand but which have no New Zealand flavour are not counted. Neither are programmes about New Zealand but made for foreign television channels.
- 8. Programme hours are divided into nine genre categories. The categories are:

Children's

Programmes which use New Zealand presenters to provide links between cartoons and other overseas material, or which have a minority of New Zealand content are classified by the amount of New Zealand content only. Programmes which contain some overseas content but have a majority of New Zealand content, such as *What Now?*, are fully classified as New Zealand programmes.

Local Content 2008

Children's Drama

This is scripted drama made for young people.

Drama/Comedy

This category contains all New Zealand-made Drama/Comedy, other than Drama made for children. Comedy is classified as Drama, not Entertainment when it is scripted and acted in accordance with usual drama production techniques (e.g. *Outrageous Fortune, The Jaquie Brown Diaries, The Unauthorised History of New Zealand* and *Go Girls*).

Documentaries

This category generally comprises one-off documentaries or series in a non-magazine format.

Entertainment

This category includes game shows, music programmes (from classical to rock), quizzes and competitions such as *The Rich List* and *Dancing with the Stars*, broad competitive formats such as *Mitre 10 Dream Home* and *Deal or No Deal* plus light entertainment shows.

Information

This category comprises a wide range of programme types, generally with a magazine format and/ or an information flavour, as opposed to an entertainment or a competitive purpose. Examples include series such as *Kai Time on the Road*; spiritual series such as *My God*; leisure and lifestyle series such as *Gone Fishin'*; and special interest series such as *Attitude* and *Tagata Pasifika*.

Maori Programmes

Programmes made for a general audience, such as *Marae, Waka Huia* and *Te Karere*, are counted in this category.

News/Current Affairs

This comprises all New Zealand-produced News/Current Affairs programmes. One-off advertised events are included, but special bulletins which have not been advertised may be excluded. For programmes which are a mixture of New Zealand and overseas material, such as 20/20, only the New Zealand portion is counted.

Sports
