

## APPLICATION DEADLINES 2021 PUBLIC INTEREST JOURNALISM FUND (PIJF)

- These are the application deadline dates for <u>Public Interest Journalism</u> applications. Please be familiar with the <u>Funding Decisions Flowchart</u>, <u>General Guidelines</u>, and the three pillars of funding under the PIJF (Projects, Roles, Industry Development).
- You must read the Current Round Information before applying. We may change any of the rounds described below, depending on funding trends.
- Round Information, including opening dates, will be issued at least three weeks before the deadline and will be available on our <u>website</u> and <u>online application</u> <u>system</u>. We'll also advise by a <u>Shorts newsletter</u>.
- We will be running a two-stage PIJF application process. This two-stage process helps manage demand on the PIJ fund and saves the sector time preparing applications. Stage 1 requires the submission of a 5-page application (including a topline budget.) The assessment panel will then decide on a shortlist of applications, which will be invited to submit full applications in Stage 2. Unsuccessful applicants will also be notified at this time.
- Stage 2 applicants will be notified the day following decisions being made. This date is dependent on the funding amount requested and may be extended at NZ On Air's sole discretion.
- We may also issue specific Request for Proposals (RFP) during the year. Deadlines for these will be specified in the RFP.
